The United Kingdom is a unitary form of the government. In fact, all powers are vested under unitary system - the parliament. Thus, unitary system is the supreme authority.

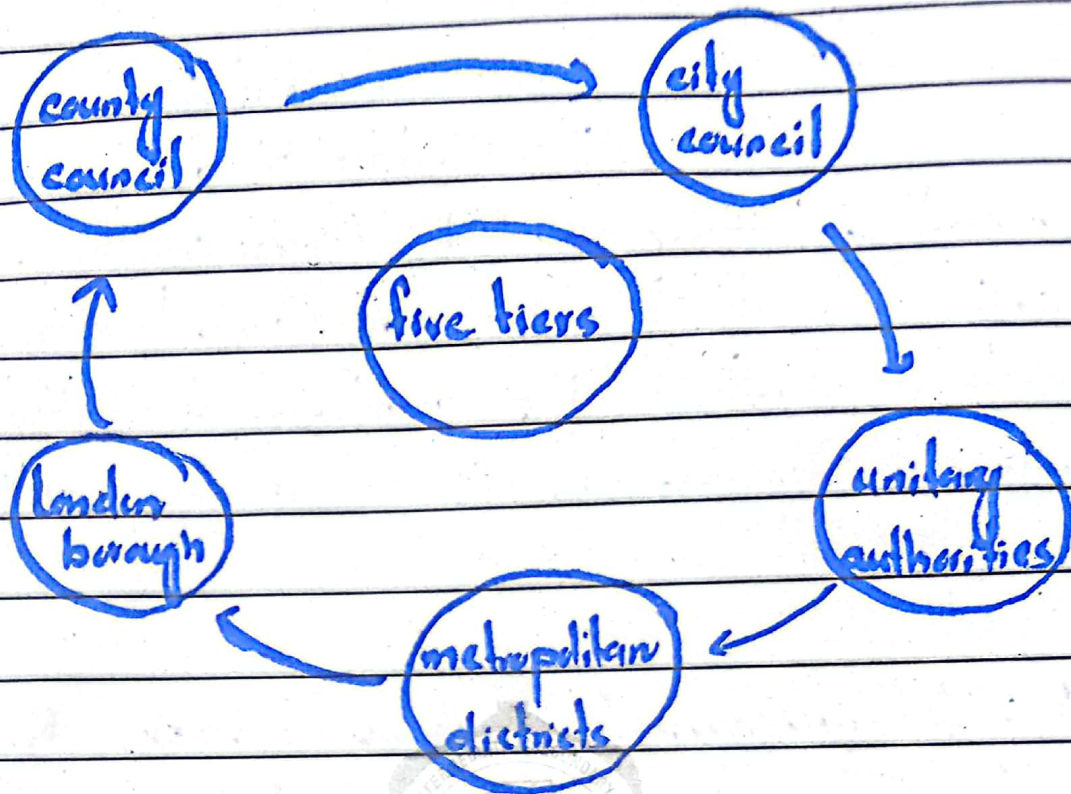
3- Local government system under the unitary system of the UK

Local government system of the UK is run by chairman and vice-chairman. Moreover, it is hierarchical model consisted of five-tiers as below:



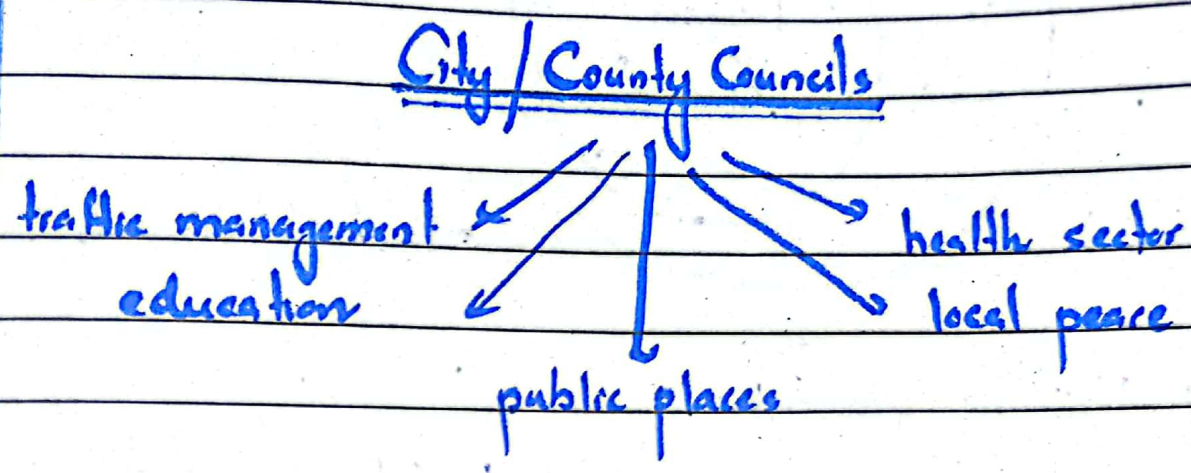
a) County councils and city councils

Thus, city and county councils are basic drivers.



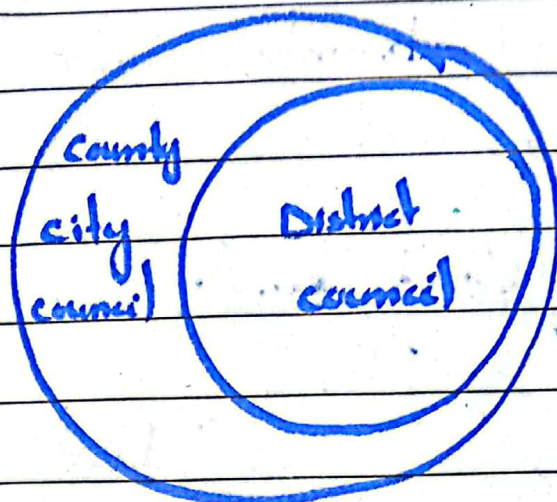
b) District councils

Thus, district councils work under county councils.

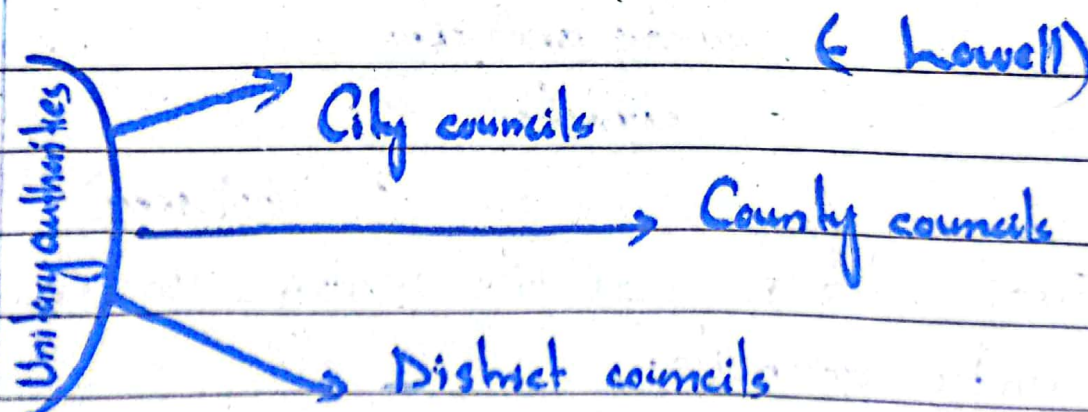


• District council

e) Town and trash management

f) Police and crime commission
