Introduction:

Gender base violence and violence against women are frequently used interchangeably in literature.

Gender base violence is violence that is directed against a person on the basis of gender.

The term gender violence reflect the idea that violence often serves to maintain structural gender inequalities, and includes all type of violence against men, women, children, adolescents, gay, transgender.

The most gender based violence is inflicted by men on women and girls. It is estimated that 20 to 25% of women in Europe have suffered physical violence.

According to the UN
Violence against women
is defined as:

Any act of
gender base violence that
result in, or is likely to result
in, physical, sexual or psychological
harm or suffering to women
including threat of such act,
Coercion or arbitrary, deprivation
of liberty, whether occurring in
private life.

Forms of violence against Women

Sexual violence:

Sexual violence is defined
as "sex through threats, physical
force, forcing unwanted sexual
acts or forcing sex with
others.

Intercourse with a girl
without his will.

- Sexual harassment is demand for sex in exchange for job promotion or higher school marks or grades.
- Trafficking for the purpose of sexual exploitation
- forced exposure to pornography
- forced pregnancy
- forced abortion
- forced marriage
- Female genital mutilation
- Virginity test
- Marital rape
- Group rape

These all use the different form of sexual violence.

Physical violence

This include violence such as Slapping, beating, arm twisting, Stabbing, strangling, burning, choking, kicking, throat with knife and murder.

It also include female genital mutilation

Economic violence:

It include act such as:
the denial funds refusal to contribute financially, denial of food and basic needs, and controlling access to health care, employment denying inheritance right in matters of property etc. all of these amalgamate into economic violence.

Psychological violence:

It include
"behaviours that intended to intimidate and persecute and takes the form of threats of abandonment or abuse, confinement to the home, surveillance, threat to take away custody of the children, destruction of objects, isolation, verbal aggression and constant humiliation."

Elucidate the current status of health of women in Pakistan. What measures could be taken to improve the women's status as whole.

Introduction:

Health is a complete mental physical and social well-being and does not mean the mere absence of disease. The health of families and nations are interlinked with the health of women. Health or death of a woman can have serious implication for the health of her children and family. If the women are healthy they will produce healthy children and they will be in a position to take care of family health, so we can say that healthy women are the sign of a healthy family. Consequently a healthy nation. Million of women die every year due to lack access of health facilities.

1 Women health issues:

Women in Pakistan has severe limitation to medical care due to multiple factors, including its rugged, diverse geography and civil unrest. These problems are specially in rural area, where travel is often limiting factor as describe by Anne G. Thinker in the publication Improving Women's Health in Pakistan. Pakistan is plagued with high rates of maternal mortality, child mortality and child malnourishment.

Moreover, There is a few female employed in health care as compare to male. mostly male health care check female patient so, many women do not tell their problems to male doctors.

i Limited Access to healthcare facilities:

Pakistan has limited healthcare facilities. Pakistan has ranked third

highest in the world with the numbers of maternal deaths.

There are many factors responsible for this issue even who wish to seek treatment have no resources. More than 60 percent women in Sindh do not have access to public health care service.

ii Lack of health awareness:

~~Women~~ ^{Extremely} ~~have~~ narrow approach to women and women health's is main cause why women are not able to get proper medical treatment. Women are at time even not allowed to undergo a medical center or visit to a doctor.

• Reliance on Traditional medicine Techniques:

The tribal and rural concept of home deliveries are another

reason why Patient remain undiagnosed of medical complications which may lead to death of infant or their mother. It also lead to abnormal children who are a burden on Parents and the Country as whole.

Poor budgetary Allocation:

The allocation of budget for health is extremely low. Pakistan has spend 0.9 percent GDP on health

Absence of Family Planning Practice

Concept of family planning is very vague in Pakistan. People are not aware to use contraceptive or birth control pills or they resist because they consider it against their moral and religious teaching. Using contraceptive is equal to killing child in our society.

Patriarchal Society:

Pakistan is a patriarchal society whose men is superior than women. Domestic violence is a chief cause of complication related to pregnancy including unwanted pregnancies, lack access to family planning, unsafe abortion, high risk pregnancy and other psychological problem.

Poverty:

Poverty is a main cause do not go to health care. People do not afford fee of doctors.

Negative role of midwives

In rural areas people believe on normal delivery with midwife. If these patient survive they still in danger. Local quacks offer cheap medicine have severe side effect.

Food and malnutrition:

Pakistan has severe issue of malnutrition

In Baluchistan 66% population have food insecurity and 36% women are under weight.

2 Solution of health issue:

Health problems being faced by women can be resolved by taking following steps

Free healthcare facilities:

Women must be provided with free health care facilities. Clinic and hospitals must be built in villages and remote areas

Awareness programmes

A country-wide awareness campaign must be launched. Lecture and workshop of women hygiene during pregnancy and menstruation must be

Abolition of Traditional medical practice

Traditional medical practice must be abolished. Women must be encouraged to visit a doctor

Removing stigma about family planning

The government must initiate program to remove the stigma about family planning. Religious leader should spread awareness with the fact that use of contraceptive is allowed in Islam

Proper Allocation of budget

At least 6 percent GDP must be assigned to women health care facilities and building clinics and hospitals.
