- f. Lack of rule of law makes people disregard laws, norms and moral codes

(4) Consequences of Moral decline in politics:-

- a. Misuse of power by ruling politicians
- b. Involvement of apolitical institutions in politics to save the State
- c. National Unity fades away
- d. Masses lose trust in state system
- e. Politicians unable to agree even on grave national issues
- f. Violent clashes between opposing political parties challenge law and order maintenance

(5) Way forward :-

- a. Impart moral education to new generation

- b. Political parties should develop and follow an agreed-upon moral code of conduct
- c. Political parties should train and groom workers' morality
- d. Public should act as watchdog of politicians' morality
- e. Non-partisan offices (e.g Speaker of NA) should enforce high moral standards
