Khartoum.

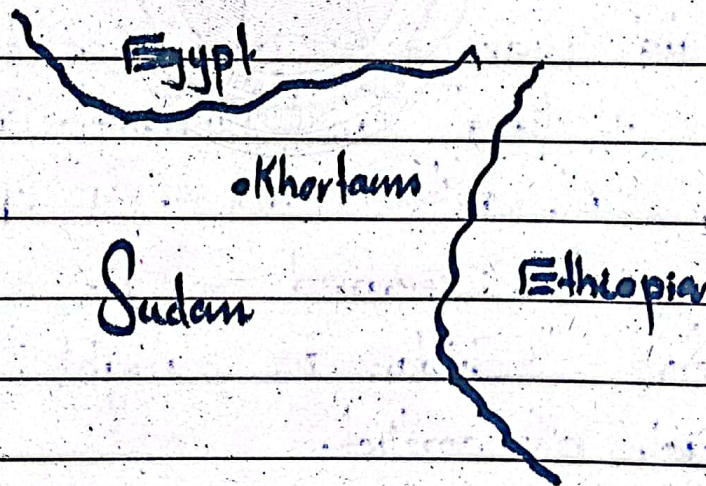

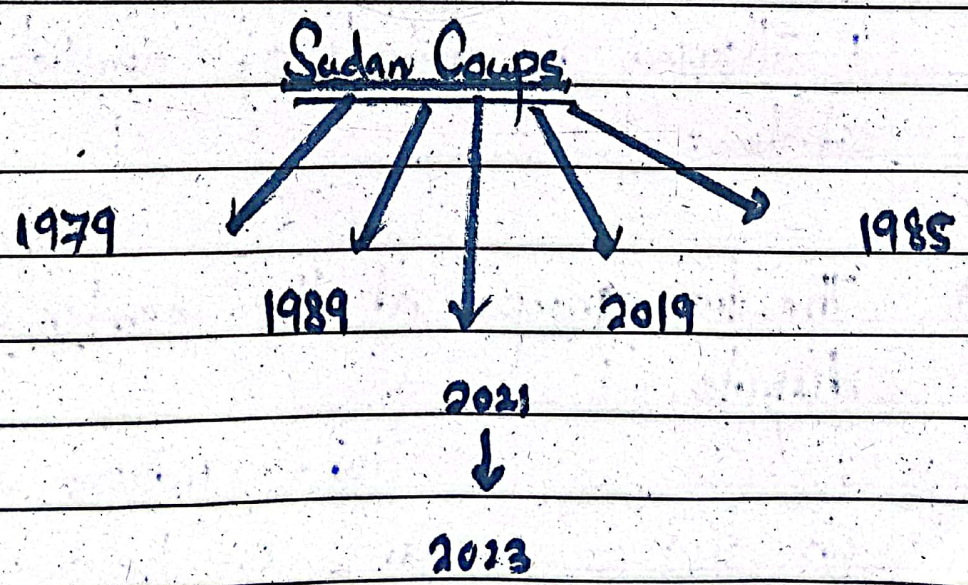
Thus, Sudan conflict is an unen-

Sudan is in a huge conflict. In April 2023, violence began in the capital, Khartoum and in other parts of the country.

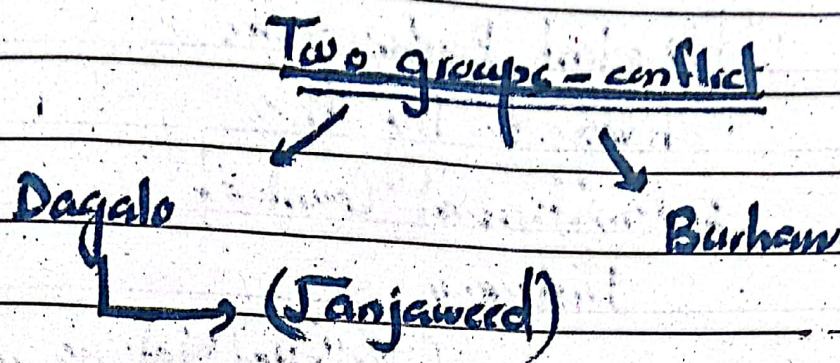
"Unfortunately the whole Sudan is caught in a fire."

(Al-Jazeera, 2012)

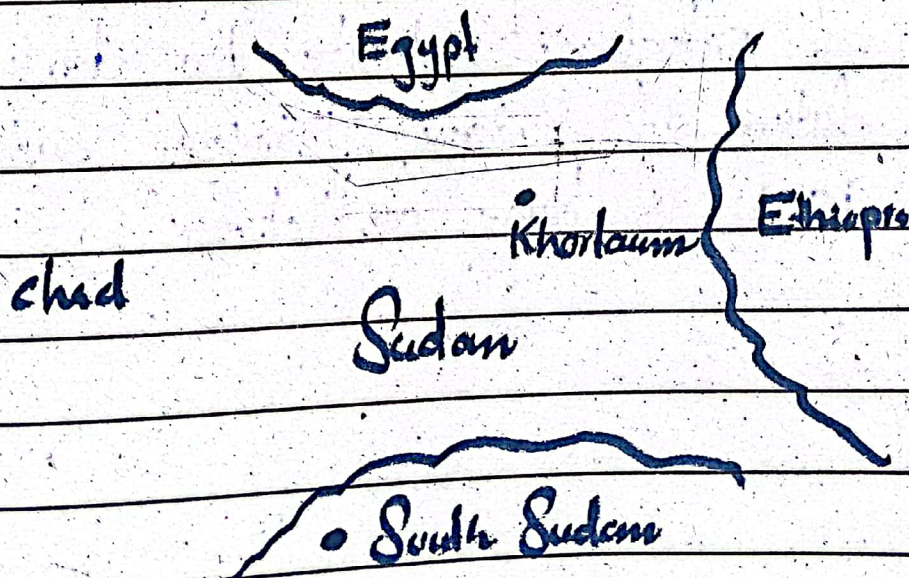
