Topic Sentence	The threat of Nuclear challenge poses a grave challenge to world peace.
Explanatory or Reasoning sentence	Nuclear weapons pose danger to humanity due to their existing stockpile.
Supporting Point (1)	There are at least 23,000 nuclear bombs still in existence - more than a third of these weapons - over 7,000 - remain operationally deployed.
Example (1)	World War 3 was escaped on a 2 to 3 vote during the Cuban Missile Crisis when a Russian Submarine lost communication with Moscow and not knowing whether a war had broken or not, the commander had to launch his nuclear torpedoes and, overwhelmed by the responsibility, put it to a vote (http://govans.org/speeches/speech430.html , November, 2010).
