9. The landlord has said to the young man, "If you don't pay your rent by evening today you will have to leave the house immediately."

The landlord has told the young man that if he did not pay his rent by evening today he would have to leave the house immediately.

10. His wife said to him, "Do you know ^{that} my servant stole ~~my~~ ^{our} money?"
His wife ^{asked} ~~told~~ him if he ~~knew~~ [✓] that her servant had stolen their money.

11. Her friend said to her, "Can you spare your book for me for a week?"
Her friend asked her if she could spare her book for her for a week. ✓

12. She said to him, "Can I do anything for you? Will you mind my extending help to you?"
She asked him if she could do anything for him. If he would

mind her extending help to him.

13. His friend has said to him, "Did I not warn you against this beforehand?"

His friend has asked him if he had not warned him against ~~this~~ ^{that} beforehand.

14. The captain said to the players, "Will you put your heart and soul in playing the game so that we may win the match?"

The captain asked the player if they would put their heart and soul in playing the game so that ~~that~~ they might win the match.
