4. Upholding Islamic moral values

In Islam, through various practices woman is ought to uphold Islamic morality in her life. This specific role of a muslim woman is not a feature of modern society.

For instance, a muslim woman unlike her modern counterpart is ordained

5. To hold public office.
In Islam as well

As women are holding public offices in modern society. The former prime minister of New Zealand, Jacinda Arden is a prominent example. However, muslim women like Halimah Jacob (incumbent president of Singapore) is also serving the same purpose.

6. Role in modern technology.

Both Islam and modern society put no restrictions upon women's role in information technology.

For example, Afiya Masim (a muslim girl) was the youngest Microsoft Certified Professional from Pakistan in 2004.

7. As a stakeholder in politics.

Either Islam or modern society, women have their role in political affairs of a country. However, in modern society, such roles are exercised in assemblies, organisations and public offices.

8. Economic role of women.

Women perform diverse range of economic roles in Islam as well as in modern society.

Women can own property, sell it or give it as charity. Furthermore, she is also allowed to participate in other economic activities in both societies.

9. Women in armed forces.

There is no doubt that women are actively participating as armed personnels in modern societies. However,

In Islam, she is also allowed to play her role in security affairs.

10. Women as Scholars.

Women have a prominent role as scholars in Islamic and modern society.

Hajrat Ayesha R.A. was an influencing woman scholar in Islamic history. Besides, Karen Armstrong stood as a strong scholar in Britain of modern times.
