All crimes are not acts of deviance but not all acts of deviance are crime.

Example: If a group of people in a public place are smoking and playing loud music, it may be seen as deviant



because they are "loitering". Even if they are not breaking the law, their behaviour maybe seen as anti-social and therefore, deviant.
