I. Introduction:

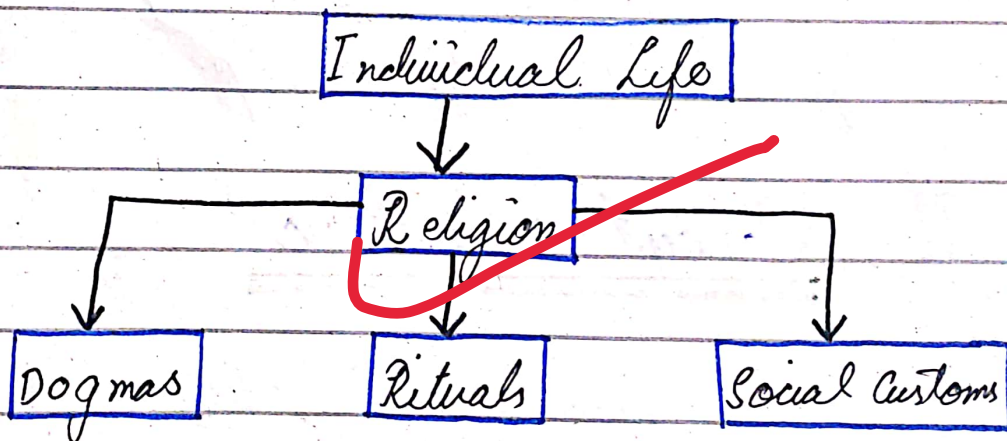
II. Concept of Religion:

on the religious doctrine and observances. Not encompassing entirety of one's life.

a. Scholar Views:

Religion often tends to be limited to a particular set of beliefs and rituals and moral framework that guides all aspects of life -- Karen Armstrong

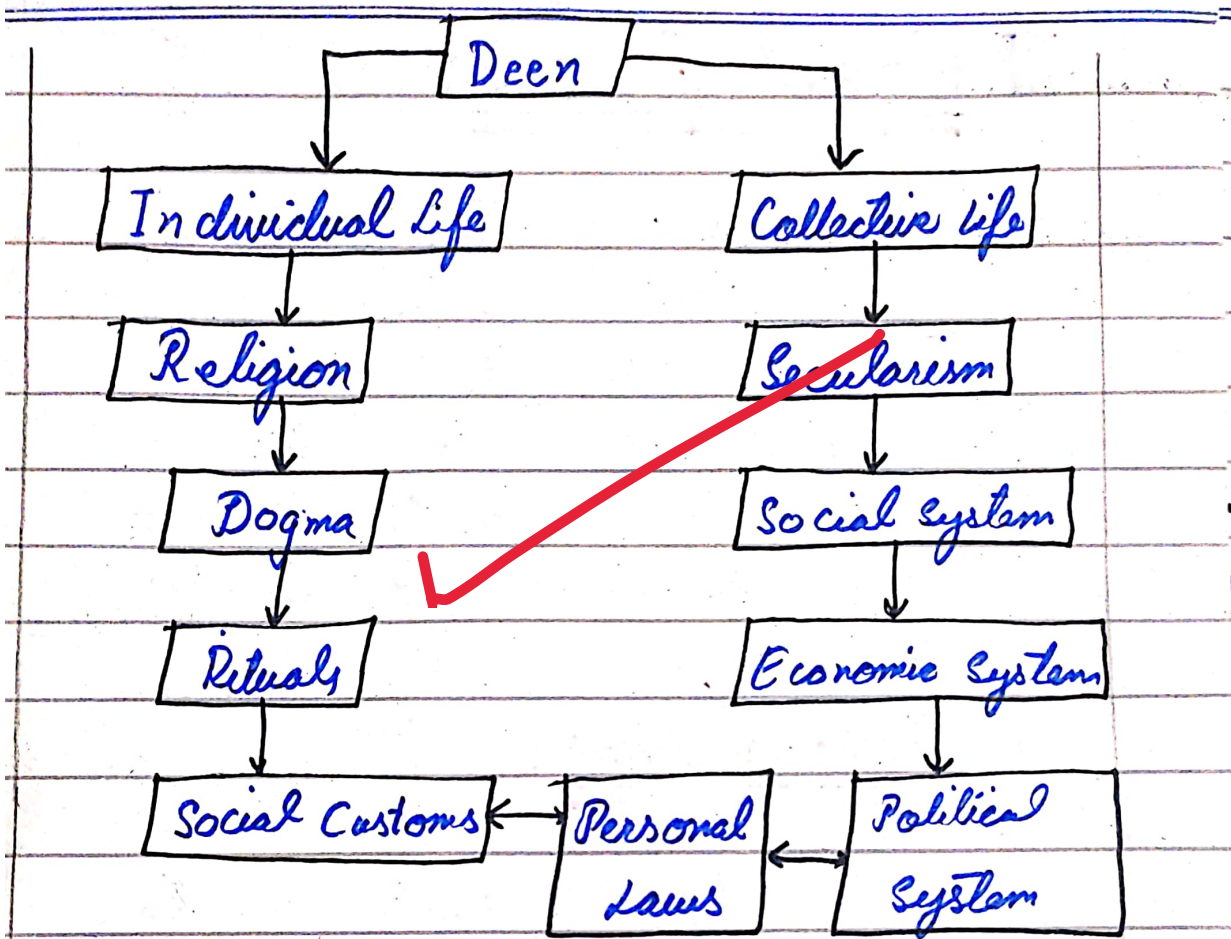


III. Concept of Deen:

In contrast to religion, Deen covers all aspects of human life. It covers both sacred as well as secular affairs of the world. In nutshell, Deen provides guidance in the individual and collective life.

a. Scholar Views:

Imam Ghazali in his book *Ihya-ul-Ulum Al Din* wrote the word "Deen" comprehends everything that concerns the servants and his lord in this world and the hereafter. It encompasses both the external and internal aspects of human being.



IV. Key differences between Deen and Religion:

a. Scope and Comprehensive Approach:

Deen encompasses all aspect of life including personal, social, moral and spiritual dimensions

Whereas religion focuses primarily on the religious doctrines, rituals, and practices associated with faith

ان الدين عند الله الاسلام

Surely (true) religion with Allah is Islam
(Al-Imran 3:19)

It is clear that only religion before Allah is Islam.

b. Holistic Integration:

Deen integrates faith with actions, ethics, and values, promoting a holistic way of life. On the other hand, religion emphasizes adherence to specific rituals and beliefs without necessarily integration with all aspects of life.

اليوم اكملت لكم دينكم واتممت عليكم نعمتي

ورضيت لكم الاسلام بنا

This day I have perfected your deen for you, completed my favor upon you, and have chosen for you Islam as your deen.

This shows that Islam deals with all aspects of life. It is a complete code of life.

C. Ethical and Moral Frame Work:

Deen emphasizes the importance of ethical behaviour, sincerity, and counsel as integral components of a comprehensive way of life. Religion emphasizes religious rituals and observances as primary expressions of faith.

اللَّهُ الَّذِي أَنْزَلَ الْكِتَابَ بِالْحَقِّ وَالْمِيزَانَ

It is God who has sent down the book which is truth, and the balance to judge right and wrong (Al-Shu'ara)

Thus, Islam guides what is right and what is wrong. Islam provides ethical and moral framework.

d. Cultural Variations:

Deen transcends cultural boundaries, providing universal principles and values applicable to people of all backgrounds. Whereas religion can be influenced by intermingled with specific cultural practices and customs.

قرآن عربیہ ذی کوج لعلم یتون

It is a Quran in Arabic without any croakadments therein, in order that they may guard against evil
(Al-Zumar)

Thus, Islam as a deen avoids cultural variations.

e. Relationship with the Divine:

Deen involves a personal and transformative connection with the Divine, seeking a spiritual growth and closeness to God.

Religion implies adherence to prescribed rituals and doctrines as means of demonstration of faith.

شهر رمضان الذي انزل فيه القرآن
هدى للناس وبيات من الهدى والفرقان

The month of Ramadan is that in which the Quran was revealed, a guidance to men and clear proof of the guidance and the distinction (Al-Baqarah)

Islam is from Allah and is a source to build healthy relation with divine

V. Importance of Deen in human life :

Following are the few positive aspects of Deen on human life

a. Give Ideology of life :

Deen is a complete code of life. It deals with

both sacred and ~~re~~ secular aspects of world. It give ideology: a path way to follow. If there will be no path then one cannot lead to any where.

Deen provide guidelines that leads to purposeful life and that will end in a good hereafter.

Mufti Menk says

"Deen is the compass that directs us towards righteous and goodness. It is the light that illuminates our path in this world and hereafter."

b. Deen makes life Simple, Rational and Practical

Deen has made life simple, rational and practical. As it provides a way to what is right and what is

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wrong. In Islam Allah emphasize on rationality. In Quran, Allah says:

“That those who do not observe and understand are worse than cattle.”

(Al-Araf)

Thus, Deen is simple, rational and practical.

c. Unity of Matter and Spirit:

Deen doesn't deal with only one aspect of life. It deals with every aspect of life. It asks to live life to life and also take care of spirit of sacredness. In Quran Allah says:

ربنا اتنا في الدنيا حسنة وفي الآخرة حسنة
وقنا عذاب النار

Our Lord! Give us something in this world as well as something fine in Hereaf

Thus, Deen will supports to live the life and also care for hereafter.
