The word 'Islam' "itself has two meanings, one is the literal meaning and the other is the contextual. Literal meaning: The root word of Islam is SLM which is an Arabic word. It means to surrender." "to yield", and "to submit" mother shade of meaning of this root word is "to make peace". In this way, the word Islam also means submission and peace. Contextual meaning: The conventional or contextual meaning of Islam is to enter in peace by submitting to the will of Allah Almighty or the submission of desires to the will of Allah. This signitions that a person can achieve real peace of body soul, and mind only through submission and obedience to Allah.

Concept of Islam: The divine teachings of Holy Clusan and the sayings of Holy Prophet [PBUH) reveal the real concept of Islam. These sources explain the submission and obedience of mah is essential and how Islam as a religion deals the complexities ethics, moral, rocial, cultural, and individual and collective life spheres of humans. In addition to this, Islam enables a man to make peace with himself and his community on one hand and with Allah Almighty on the other hand It is a trusted source of guidance that brings forth the truths of material life and the metaphysical realm It caters to the meterial as well as spiritual needs of a human. It is said in the Holy Ousan, "There is no doubt in this book - a guidance to the prous, who believe in the Unseen".
