5) My father ~~told~~ ^{said to} me, "I fear that you have caught cold again."

→ My father told me that he fear ^{ed} that I had caught cold again.

6) His brother said to me, "I am not going to attend meeting today."

→ His brother told me that he was not going to attend meeting that day.

7) The inspector has said to the people, "We have caught the thief and he will be brought to book soon".

→ The inspector ~~has~~ informed the people that they had caught ~~the~~ thief and he would be brought to book soon.

8) The lady said to her husband, "whether you agree with me or not I am not going to change my decision".

→ The lady told to her husband that whether he ~~agreed~~ with her ~~do~~ or not she was not going to change her decision.

9) The landlord said to the young man, "if you do not pay ~~you~~ ^{the} rent by evening today you will have to leave the house immediately".

→ The landlord warned the young man that if he did not pay the ~~rent~~ by evening that day he would have to leave the house immediately.

10) His wife said to him, "Do you know that my servant stole our money".

→ His wife asked her ~~that~~ whether he ~~know~~ that her servant had stolen their money.
