Definition

"The way of life shared by group of people. It encompasses language, religion, cuisine, social habits, arts & architecture etc is termed as culture."

Importance Of Culture in Islam

Islamic Culture is deeply rooted in the teachings of Quran and Sunnah of Prophet ﷺ. It encompasses of the beliefs, practices, values and social systems that define the way of providing identity, unity, social development and more.

Provides a Community with identity:

In Islam, Culture provides Muslims with a distinct

identity that is defined by their faith. The identity is expressed through various aspects of life including religious practices, dress, language and customs. Islamic identity is rooted in the concept of Ummah the global Muslim community united by the belief in one ALLAH.

Quranic Reference:

The Quran emphasizes the importance of a collective identity based on one faith.

“This your community, is one community and I am your Lord, so worship Me.” (Surah- al- anbiya)

Provides A Sense Of Unity

Islamic Culture fosters a unity

among Muslims through shared religious practices, values and beliefs. The concept of brotherhood is central to Islam, encouraging Muslims to support and care for one another, regardless of ethnic or cultural differences.

Quranic Reference:

"And hold firmly the rope of ALLAH all together and do not become divided."

(Surah-Al-Imran)"

Positively Impacts the Social Development of a Society

Islamic Culture has a profound impact on the social development of a society by promoting values such as justice, compassion and mutual respect.

Islamic teachings guides individual to act with integrity and fairness in their interaction with others, thereby fostering a just and harmonious Society.

Hadith Reference:

Prophet ^ﷺ said:

"The best of people are those who are most beneficial to people."

Strengthens a Community:

Islamic Culture Strengthens a community by fostering strong social bonds based on mutual respect, cooperation and shared religious practices. The concept of Shura in Islam encourages collective decision making and cooperation within community. Islamic teachings also emphasize the needy and maintaining

Provides a Sense of Patriotism
