## Score of battles fought by <sup>results</sup> Holy prophet

After the migration to Madina, from 622 to 632, he fought 27 battles that are known as ghazwaat.

The battles where Holy prophet was not present are known as Samiyah, which were 73 in number.

### 1) Forbidden attacks by night

### 2) Forbid immolation of enemies

Being a prudent military strategist, he always thought for the persecution.

He strongly shunned the act of burning body of enemies.

### 3) Forbid the killing of envoys ✓

Prophet  $\text{ﷺ}$  strongly commanded to abstain from killing any diplomat of another state.

### 4) Forbid the killing of any pledged person. ✓

Do not kill a person who has a covenant with someone, and do not kill the captives.

(Hadith) ✓

### 5) Forbin the destruction of trees and animals ✓

As prophet  $\text{ﷺ}$  is known for his generosity, with that, he possessed the soft corner for animals and

Living things like trees and plants.

## 6) Forbidden the killing of Women and Children.

While dictating to the warriors, he strongly restricted all to abstain from making women or child captives.

## Qualities of Holy prophet
