For two decades Pakistan has been banned militant groups. But this banned group deactivate for short time, and then after Nawaz's era

The Hazir Gul Bahadur group and Baloch Separatist group linked with TTP have been entered to the Nato's list. Furthermore, the state has labelled TTP as "Fitna al Khawarij". The state is using historical and religious terms, but some deeper investigation are needed to outlaw these terrorist

However, the sectarian group named as "Laskar-i-Jhangvi" was banned by Musharraf regime instead. In addition to this ~~some~~ other five group of militant was dismissed in January 2002. In his regime he had to keep stick Pakistan with American demand of "with us or against us".

Even though after passing 22 years of that event the list of terrorist

grouped increases from five to six groups to 81, the state has fragile approach towards these group prohibition.

After the dismissal of their strength they need change their agenda names and practice terrorism freely.

To prohibit the resurgence of terrorism, state representative, civil force should work thoroughly.
