Question:

What is Islam? Elaborate the salient features of Islam?

Meaning OF Islam:-

The literal meaning of Islam is to submitting, surrender to the will of God. Islam is an arabic word that denotes the following terms Submission, Surrender and Obedience. As a religion, Islam stands for complete submission and obedience to the God. That is why it is called "Islam."

The other literal meaning of Islam is "peace." This signifies that one can achieve real peace of body and of mind only through the submission

and obedience to "Allah."

Such a life of obedience brings peace of the heart and establishes the real peace in society at large.

"Islam is a way of life which opens the heart to the meaning of existence."

In Shariah, the meaning of Islam is same as mentioned above but with the addition of one word that is "voluntary." The submission of one's own desire for the sake of Allah including one's own will without any pressure.

"There shall be no compulsion in [acceptance of] the religion. The right course has become clear from the wrong."

1 Unique Concept OF

Tauheed:-

In Islam, there is unique concept of tauheed. Tauheed means "oneness" and "uniqueness." Tauheed means that there is absolutely no one worthy of worship other than Allah. The comprehensive concept of Tauheed is given in the Surah Al-Ikhlās.

"Say: He is Allah, the One and Only: Allah, the Eternal, Absolute. He begets not nor is He begotten. And there is none comparable to him."

Tauheed means Oneness of Allah. There is no God except Allah. To become a Muslim, it is compulsory to believe in the concept of Tauheed.

"Tauheed is first chapter of Islamic Syllabus."

2- Prophethood:-

Prophethood is the second unique feature of Islam. To become a muslim, it is also compulsory to believe in Prophethood.

Allah gives us Quran (the complete guide) through his Prophet (P.B.U.H). Muhammad (P.B.U.H) is his last prophet and Allah complete his deen toward us.

Prophethood is the second chapter of Islamic Syllabus. It also includes the believe in "finality of Prophethood."

The second part of Kalma-e-Tayyaba is:

"Muhammad (P.B.U.H) is the Messenger of Allah."

Muhammad is not the father of [any] one of your men, but [he is] the messenger of Allah and last of the Prophets. And ever is Allah, of all things, knowing.

3- Universal Code of Life:-

Islam is unique as it is universal. It acknowledge us about every event of our life. It guides us in individual as well as collective life. It gives knowledge, guidance, information regarding following:

a. Upbringing Of Children:

Islam provide us knowledge regarding the birth, upbringing and the death of child. The

upbringing of child is very important regarding Islamic point of view. After birth, the Azan was given in the ear of child in order to start his journey in this world with the name of "Almighty Allah."
