

Fifthly, in addition to feudalism, fifth comes the military department that represents manifests the colonial mentality which has hinders Pakistan's Progress. Military play the same repressive role in the present day as they did in colonial times. They considered themselves superior and the public inferior. This is evident that they are enjoying special privileges like colonial masters, better salary structure than civilians. They interfere in the public affairs to manipulate according to their interests. They also manipulate even the politicians to get the favours from them in their personal affairs. For example, The Ex Lt. General arrests due to manipulate the media and also <sup>found corruption</sup> charges. They have also separate parks to enjoyment. Similarly, the military interventions in Political affairs make Pakistan unstable.

in terms of economically and also politically. About 30 years military dictators ruled over the country and influenced over the country's institutions like judiciary. General Pervaiz Musharraf ~~over~~ from the judges of Supreme Court to control & worked according to his dictations. The oth was according to PCO. In this way the other military dictators obrogated the constitution and gave dictations according to their own interests. From this move of the military generals Pakistan did not progress in such way that Pakistan could economically & also politically. Therefore, the colonial mentality in military had seriously damaged the economical & political progress of Pakistan.

In addition to military department, Sixth comes the educational institutes that represents a big hurdle as represented the colonial mentality. During the British colonial era, the English language was to be known as superior language because of the Britisher Rulers. But in the present day, this concept of the language has been followed. Now a days the English Medium education has been prioritized instead of Urdu which is our national language and also the Madrassa system considers as inferior. Even in the Judiciary, military, and police departments also opted this language as a basic need. The Judges gave their judgements in the cases are also written in the English language. This approach of the language was also opted by the Britishers in their colonial times.

But we opted this language to make superior from the other people of the country. Similarly, Even in the educational system, English language is obligatory to learn. From <sup>Prep</sup> One to Master level it is the basic need instead ~~of~~ national language. This language considers superior to the other languages and other languages are considered as inferior. Even Higher Education system emphasizes to opt English courses and Higher Education only offers all courses in English language. Hence, the colonial approach in the educational institutions had been seen seriously hindered the progress of Pakistan.
