⇒ The lady told her husband that whether he agreed with her or not she was not going to change her decision.

9, The land lord has said to the young man, "If you do not pay your rent by today evening, you will ~~be~~ have to leave the house."

⇒ The land lord ~~has~~ told the young man that if he does not pay his rent by evening that day, he will have to leave the house.
