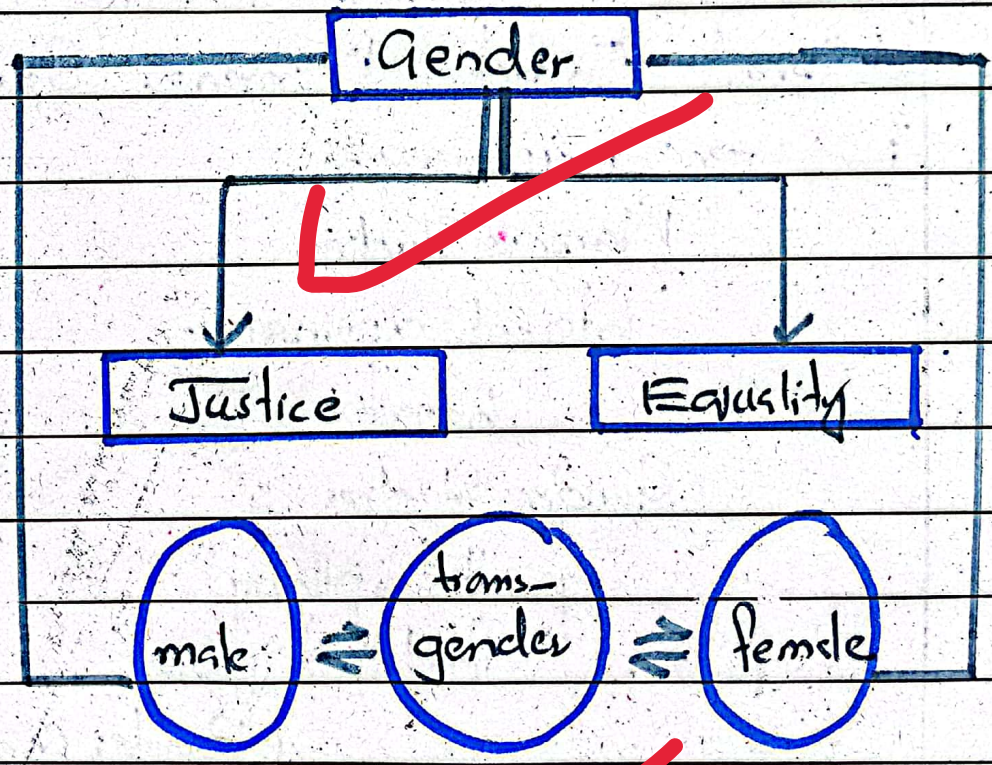

This shows that both have different nature.

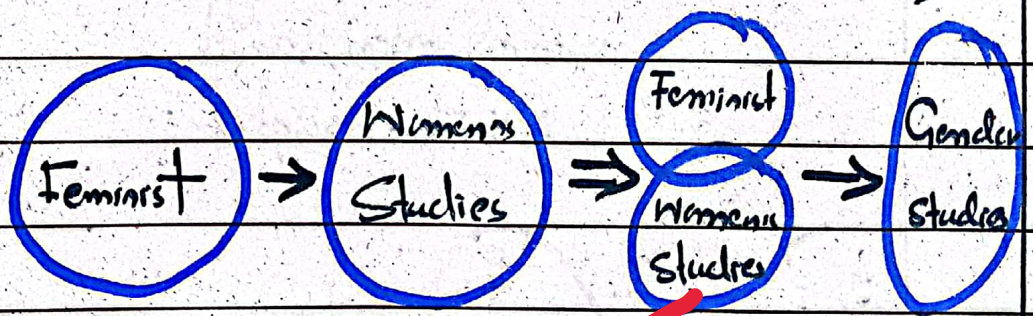
b) Origin of Women and Gender Studies

c) Focus of Women and Gender Studies

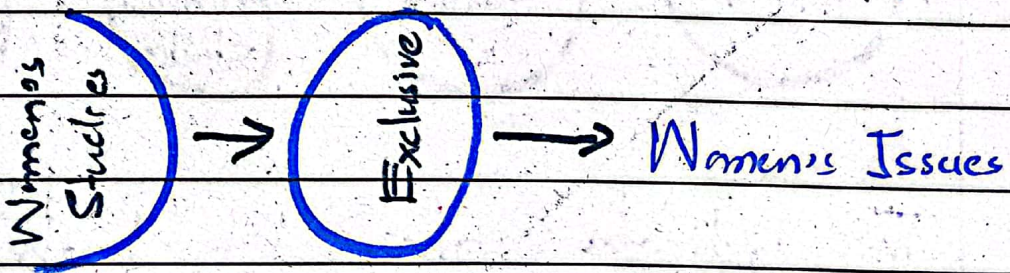
Further, both Gender and Women's Studies possess different focus. There is slightly difference.

"Women's Studies sole focus is issues of women"

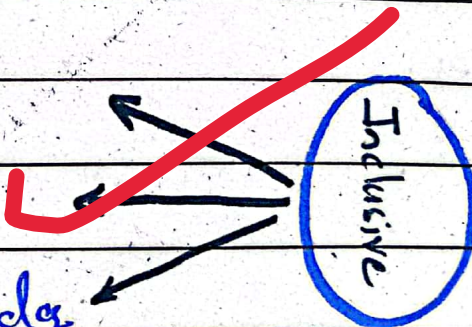

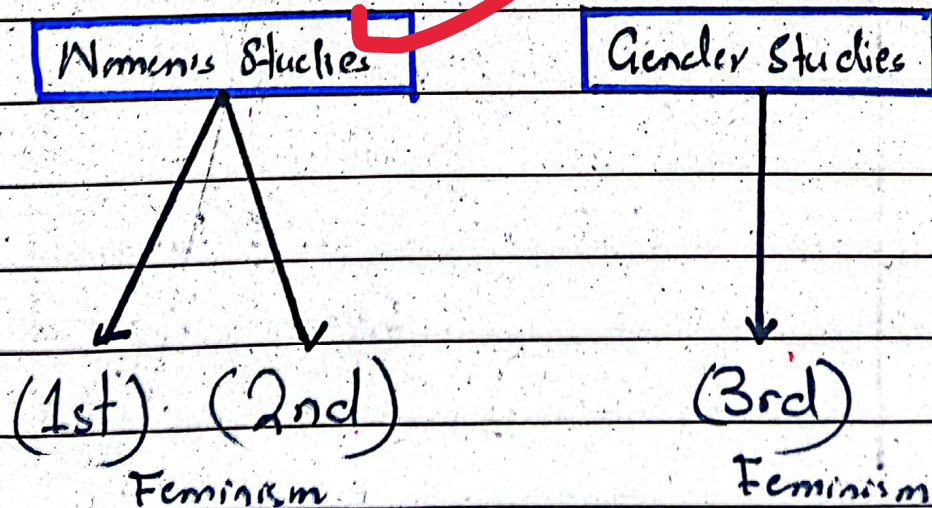
Furthermore, Womens Studies is 'early-developed feminist thought. However, Gender Studies is advanced.

Additionally, Women's Studies achievement is inclusive in Gender Studies.

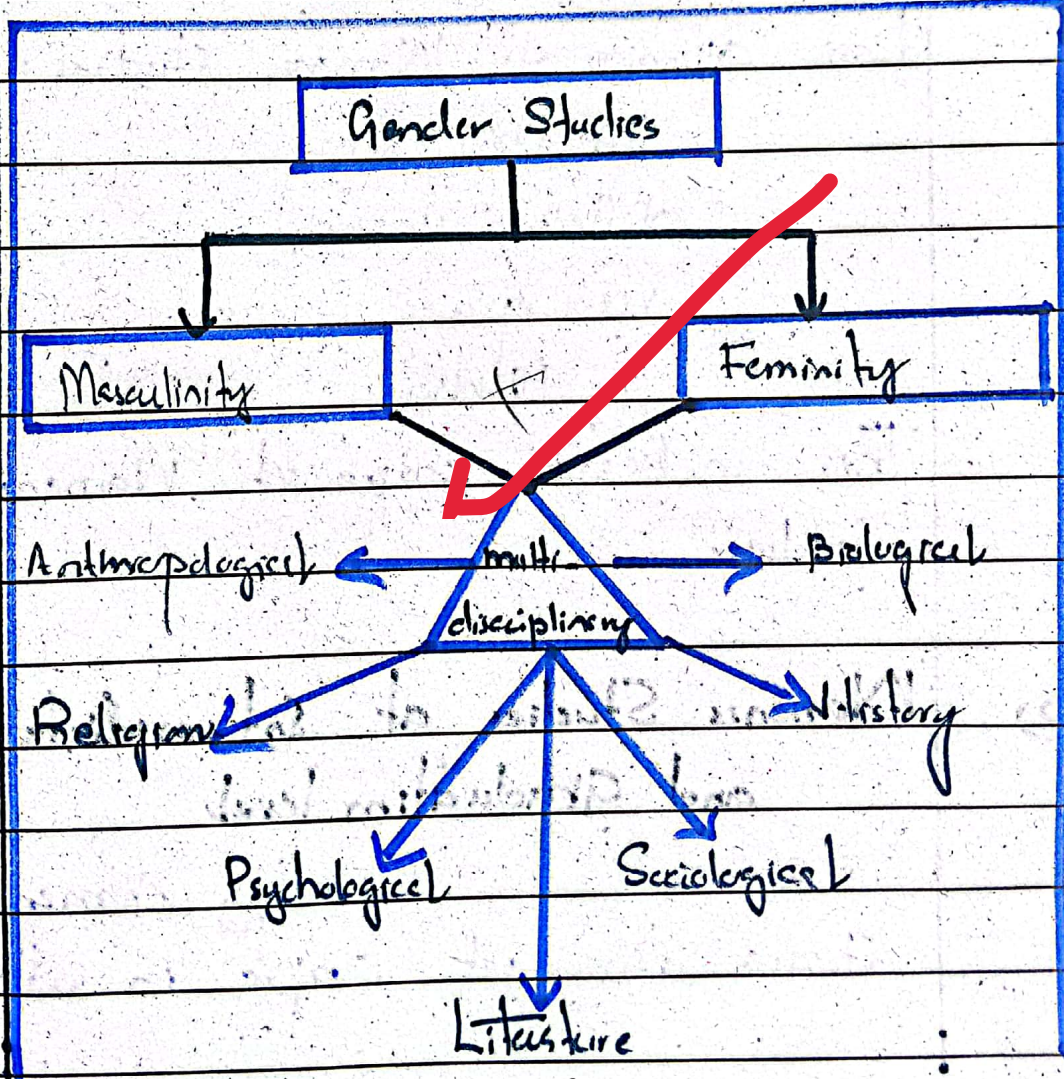
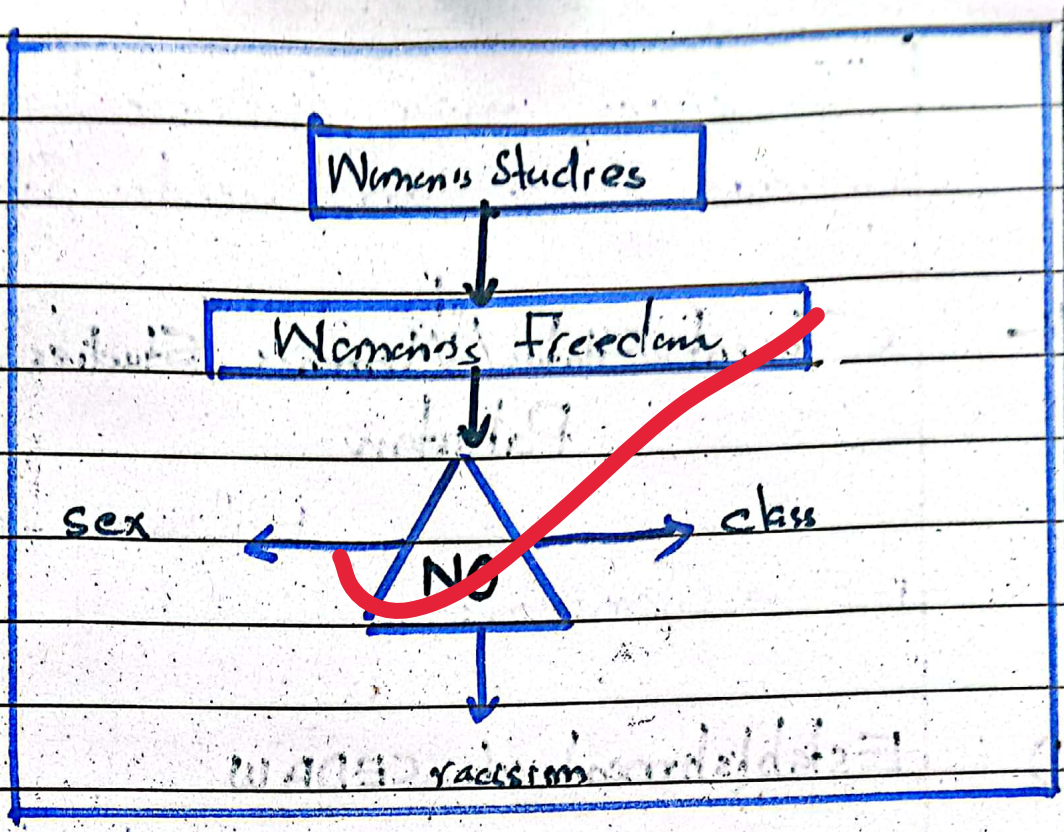
