## Introduction:-

Islamophobia is an unnecessary and groundless culture of fear against Muslims and Islam. Islamophobia term may be defined sociologically as the fear that western society has against Muslims. Even though the root of that pathology, which specially escalated after 11/9 of September 2001, terminology came out in late 80s that fear and conflict has deep roots in the history of the west. However, after 9/11 incident, the interest in studying religion-based ideologies fueling terrorism and violent extremism has been renewed.

## The rise of fifth wave of Global Terrorism (Islamophobia)

Several books have also been written on religious militancy by western authors. Some adequately describe various militant organizations and their motives while others explain the importance of ideology. Some of Pakistani writers Dr. Shehryar Khan and Ishtiaq Jafar focus on narratives in their article titled "Counter ~~terrorism~~ terrorism: The war of narratives and ideology or religion".

David C. Rapoport "The four waves" in the first wave of terrorism can be attributed to anarchist, who remained inactive in violence and terrorist act from the ~~19th~~ 19th to 20th century. The second wave of terrorism during 1960s and 1970s made up the third wave, in it the emergence of anti colonial and nationalist movement. While the fourth wave of terrorism was religiously motivated terrorism, according to Rapoport starting with the wake of 1979 and continuing to date.
