Efforts to purge Muslim society.

- 1:- He sent disciples in all directions of the sub-continent to preach true version of Islam. He guided his disciple to focus on

Itbat-i-sunnah and commandments of Shariah. This method resulted in very positive outcomes. Islam and its teaching were conveyed to a vast number of areas and resultantly, the number of the followers were increased.

2: Sending letters to prominent scholars.

Another approach by Sheikh Ahmad Sirhindi to reform and purge Muslim society was sending letters to prominent scholars of all Muslim countries in which he explained to true and authentic religious doctrine of Islam. Here also, he put great stress on the following of Prophet (SAW). In this way, true version of Islam was spread more and more which resulted in the establishment of Muslim identity.
