1.	Islamophobia:	
	Islamophobia is a widespread phenomenon characteris	
	-zed by fear , prejudice and hostility towards Islam	
	and Muslims. This fear issue is present in both	
	Muslim Western and non-western societies and is	

promoted through negative media potrayals. ignorance and political agendas. Islamophobia ereates discrimination, hate priolence and policies that marginalize muslims- Because of this Muslims cannot practice their religion freely and safely. One significant incident of Islamophobia was the "Christchurch mosa & shooting in New Zealands in 2019," where a white supremacist targeted Muslim worshippers, Killing 51 people during Friday prayer. Interest - based economic system (Piba):-The dominance of interest - based economic system poses a significant challenge for Muslims, as riba (interest) is strictly prohibited in Islam. This economic system fosters inequality, exploitation and social injustices which are against the lumic principles of equality fairness and equity. Despite the clear prohibition, many muslims find themselves entangled in interestbased dealings due to the global economic structure. 3. Sectarianism: Sectorianism is another critical issue dividing the Muslim Ummah. It arises from differences in theological interceptions and historical grievances between various Islamic sects, primarily Sunni and Shia communities these divisions lead to violence and of mity, weakening of Ummah and detracks from the core message of Islam, which emphasizes brother hood and unity.
