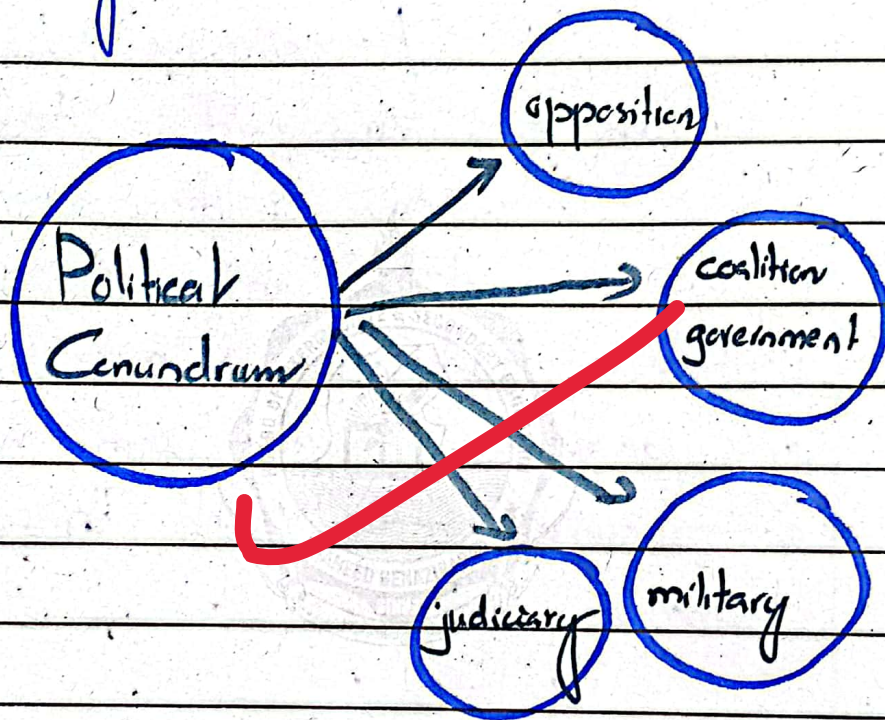

Unfortunately, Pakistan has been suffering from the severe political stress since the last two decades. Political disharmony among leaders has put the country at stake.



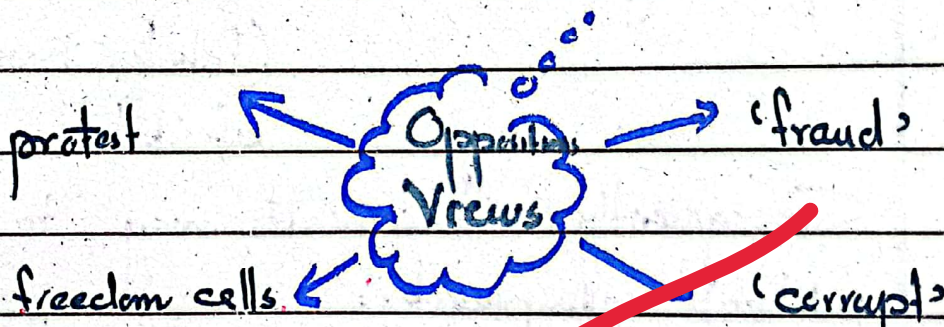
3- Evaluation of complex political situation

public forum."

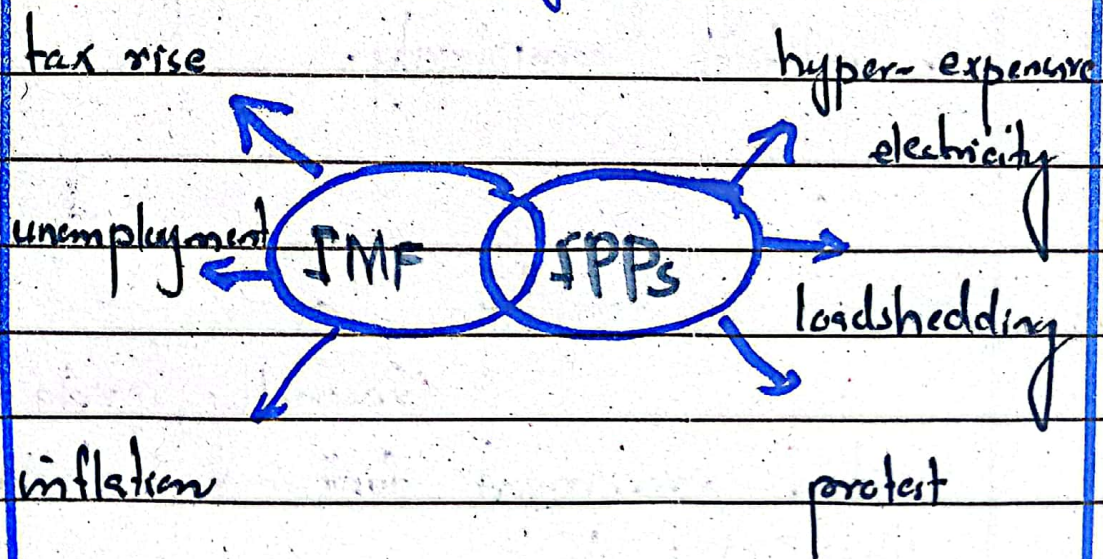

Thus, electoral reforms ensure stable politics. (The PIDE, 2024)

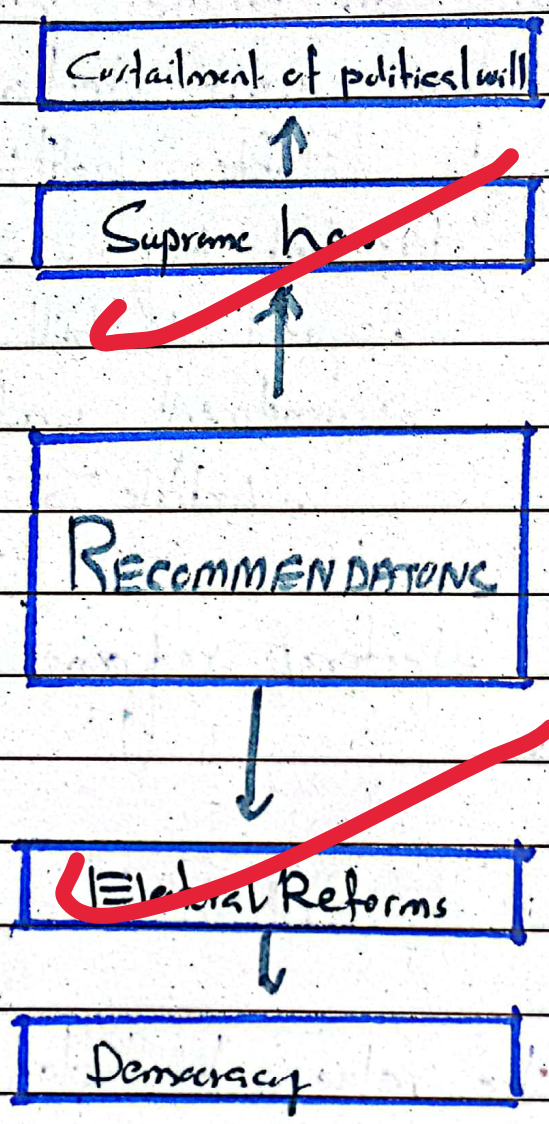
d) Value to democracy
