Three important women who have had a significant impact on others are Elizabeth Cady Stanton, Sandra Day O'Connor, and Malala Yousafzai. Elizabeth Cady Stanton was a leader of the women's rights movement in nineteenth century. In contrast, Malala Yousafzai became known when she was shot by the Taliban for standing up for the rights of girls to be educated.

Firstly, she became the symbol of courage and proved that individual determination could change major mindsets. She became a challenge for terrorist organization and created more difference in extreme adversity. Secondly, she was the youngest Nobel Peace Prize recipient and her speech on United Nations forum enhanced her power to talk about women's education in tribal areas, and created impact on global leaders to take the actions on women's education. She brought the cultural and societal impacts on people and enforced the pressure on the state at international platform.¹
