As Education gives

3- Factors responsible for impeding Pakistan's education system to materialize

A - Interference of government in academic and administrative affairs of institutions (appointment of VCs, Principals)

B) Too little spending on education (Pakistan's average spending is 1.5-2% of GDP; much lesser than UNESCO minimum allocation requirement, i.e., 4% of GDP)

C - Broad stratification of education: elite private institutions, governmental institutions and madarassas

D - Divisive education system leading to extreme forms of conflict and polarization (example of Sri Lanka and Nazi Germany)

E - Transmissive and outdated pedagogy methods: favouring elites to control marginalized (Zia's islamization of education)

F- Neoliberal narrative of education: producing monoculture minds with robotic thinking

4- Pragmatic measures to revive education system of Pakistan:

A- Establishing robust legal and constitutional protection for education; free from government's interference
(Progress in British education)

B- Ensuring transparent, effective and equitable distribution of funds
(a minimum of 4% of GDP)

C- Shifting from transmission to transmissive based advanced pedagogy to develop
-peace-loving, civilized, tolerant human

D- Conducting financial and performance accountability; professional audits by independent bodies

E) A free campus audience to have academic excellence and promote critical analysis

F- Encouraging research to help human understanding and addressing societal problems
