

Q: What is belief in the day of judgement?

Explore its effects on individual & collective life of human beings (2021)

Introduction

The day of judgement (Qayamah) means when every inhabitant will be alive by the command of Allah. The belief in the day of judgement is an important part of Islam which is necessary that every Muslim must believe in this. Allah Almighty has stated many times in the Quran and the Holy prophet (P.B.U.H) describe about the day of judgement. It has a vast impact on individual life such as it strengthens the mankind to stand with the right and opposed openly to the oppression. It purifies the heart and activities of human being. Collectively, it creates the sense of fraternity in society. Therefore, it is an very important component of Islam.

Day of Judgement

In Quran's first chapter "Surah Al-fatihah" Allah Almighty tells about the day of judgement as:

"Master of the day of judgement"
(Al-Qur'an)

It is showing the importance of the day of resurrection when every living will be given as what he did in the world. The two destinations Paradise (Jannah) and Hell (Jahannam) are part of it, ~~the~~ day of judgement will decide who have good deeds and bad deeds. Allah describe in Quran that One day of Hereafter will equal to fifty thousand years of earth. Many times in the Quran, Allah ~~warns~~ the believers from hell and ~~rewards~~ for those who will be stayed on the right path. One's Prophet (P.B.U.H) describe the time of his Ummah and the day of judgement.

as Oneness of Allah, belief on Angels,
four Holybooks, Prophets and the
last sermon as well as the belief on
the day of judgement is important.

On that day, Allah will reward to
those who fought in the way of right
path and did good deeds in their
lives and Allah will punished to those
who disobey him in their worldly lives.

Therefore, Every pious person who belief
in the day of judgement, spends his
life according to the sayings of
Allah Almighty and the prophet (P.B.U.H)
to get reward on the day of reward
(Yourn ud Din).

Effect on individual life of human being

It is the day where everyone get as per they have done in the world.

It shapes the individual life in an optimistic way for its ownself and give strength to stand for the right and afraid only to the Allah Almighty.

(i) It prevents from evil deed

Allah sets some boundaries for human being and who will cross these boundaries will be punished on the day of judgement.

The major evil deeds are idolatry, adultery, alcohol, allegation on the innocent, taking or giving interest.

The minor evil deeds are taunting, back biting, dishonesty. When a believer belief on the day of judgement, he knows that Allah will ask him about its deeds that he did in the world.

ii) Strengthen the mankind to stand against the oppression

The believer only afraid to Allah and believes in that all authority is in the hand of Allah and no one can harm until and unless Allah want.

As for instance, Hazrat Abubak (R.A) took stand for Hazrat Bilal (R.A) who was the slave of Makkah's leader and he was being oppressed due to he converted into Muslim. Hazrat Abu Bakr (R.A) free him from the slavery of Makkah.

These acts done only for the sake of Allah that Allah will rewarded them in Hereafter.

iii) Purification of Heart & itself

It purifies heart as well and pure the worship of the believer. The pious

Person will do all the things that will please Allah Almighty in the world and in Hereafter. As in the Hadith, Prophet (P.B.U.H) states about the ethics and etiquettes to adopt for the sake of Allah and get reward in Hereafter

Whoever believes in Allah and the last day, should not hurt his neighbour and whoever believes in Allah and the last day, should serve his guest generously and whoever believes in Allah and the day of judgement, should speak what is good or kept silent

- (Hadith)

It purifies the heart and the individual self from malignity, backbiting, hate, taunting, bad habits and so on.
