2- Gender based violence

a. Definition

According to UN:

Any act of gender based violence that result in or likely to result in physical, sexual and psychological harm or suffering to women, including threat to such acts, coercion or arbitrary deprivation of liberty, whether in public or private life. ”

↳ Types of Gender based violence:

Basically, there are two types

- (i) Direct violence.
- (ii) Indirect violence.

(i) Direct violence.

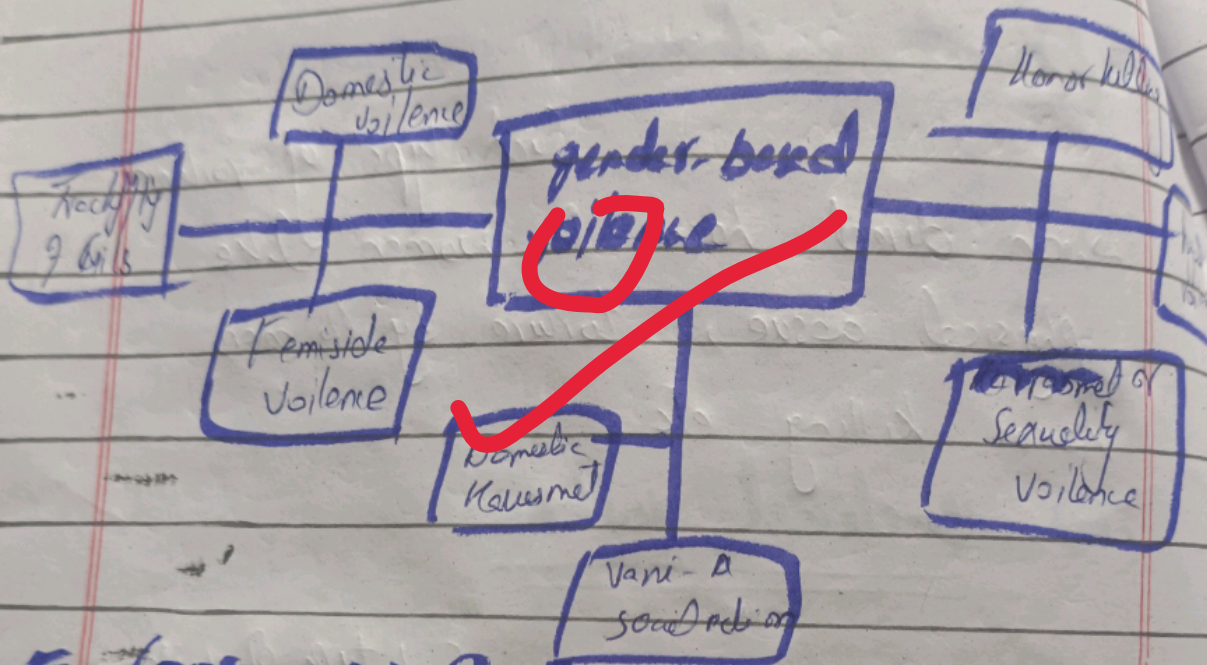
Such type of violence which direct harm to women like physical abuse, torture by men, honor killing etc.

(ii) Indirect violence.

Such type of violence in which societal institution, systems, cultural orientation of society can harm, disadvantage people like girls (as per), Denial of rights of inheritance or abortion, free child marriage etc.

This type further divide into Cultural violence where those violence that harm the cultural cooperation and the Structural violence that for gaining economic growth and exploit become poorer and poorer.

Forms of violence in Punjab



Consequences of them:

a. Physical abuse:

It is such violence in which unlawfully met by physical force and sometimes lead to death.

Noor Mayaddeen Case 2022. She was assaulted, hurt and till to death by his husband Zaher Jaffer in Islamabad.

2- Sexuality abuse & violence

Such violence in which someone force to sex with person's consent like Rape, Sexual harassment.

Mukhtara Mai case - 2002

A lady who was raped by four person by no consent or decision of his panchayat.

3- Honor Killing

Such violence in which someone kill to person for sake of honor and in society it is not a crime because it is done for society norms.

Qandeel Baloch case 2016

Qandeel Baloch victim of honor killing by his brother Waseem.

3- Feminine violence:
