a. According to UN Women Organization, 21% of professional women athletes have experienced sexual abuse as child in sport which is double the rate in male athlete (i.e. 11%).

iv. Social pressure on young girls compel them to quite sports

a. By the age of 14, girls drop out of sports twice the rate of boys.

v. Fewer opportunities and places for women to exercise and play:

a. In rural areas, the access to sport venue are often huddled by unsafe neighborhoods and security concerns.
