risky for foreign investors.
This has impeded progress of
Bangladesh manifolds. So, image of
a country is another parameter

Sometimes macrolevel
indicators are showing the economy
as flourishing like reduced inflation
but at microlevel people are
suffering for basic necessities.
Pakistan is a case in point, where
currently the inflation reduced to
significantly lower levels but the
people are still not able to afford
the basic commodities. This happens
when there are restrictive monetary
policies. This mirage of stability
calls for change!

China is a
case in point, the country which
made several changes in its
process to ~~earn~~ get progress. China
shifted from a centrally planned
economy to a market oriented

economy, By leveraging cheap labor and infrastructure investment. China ~~begin~~ also developed good foreign relations not just with developed countries but with the developing nation like Pakistan. China shifted to innovations and so the big names like Huawei, Ali Baba and others are all products of China. China focused on the lifestyle of individuals means microlevel development. ~~by alleviating~~ poverty, illiteracy etc.

Therefore, China made significant changes in her operations to get progress.

The case of Turkey is another example of change driven progress. Turkey went through major changes because initially it was an autocratic government with military coup having the reigns of government but then shifted to ~~the~~
