On the flip side, women can either maintain the status quo or make the world worse. Margaret Thatcher made no difference to women's cause at all.

However, women's role is increasing in various fields where they are challenging the status quo and overhauling the existing system.

Women avoid wars and violence.
It is a psychological characteristic of women
that they do not indulge in wars. The
contemporary wars are all fought by
states who are ruled by men. "No
two countries run by women would ever
go to war" (Sheryl Sandberg, 2022). Their
Furthermore, there is psychological evidence
that women tend to be more collaborative
and less likely to attack. Men are more
overconfident individuals more likely to attack
(Over D.P. Johnson, Overconfidence in wargames, 2006)

War in Ukraine and Palestine are a result
of overconfidence of Putin and Netanyahu.
respectively. So it is evident that women
are more likely to engage in dialogue and
avoid conflict.

Women not only avoid wars, but
places 'human' at the center of decision
making process. Women in general decision-making
take bottom-up approach to ensure holistic
and human-centred decisions. Women build
adopt empathetic, collaborative and consensus
building leadership styles. For example, Sheikh
Hasina Wazed, PM of Bangladesh successfully
brought down population levels by making
human security at the center of decision-
making apparatus. Similarly, they also
their policies are more effective. Having

more women in decision-making increases the general level of public effectiveness and accountability in a country" (UNDP, Women's Participation in Decision-making, 2020). Hence, women leadership ensures humane decision-making.

By placing human at the center of decision-making, societies society is strengthened and equality is ensured. Women leaders strengthen weaker segments of the society and ensure equality in treatment. Women in position provides fair and equitable treatment. "The mere presence of female leader relative to male leader leads to fair treatment in the organization" (Tashi, My Fair Lady? Inferring Org. Trust from mere presence of women in leadership roles, 2022). Thus, appointing women in leadership roles will lead to a more fair and equitable society.

Fair Equality of treatment will eliminate patriarchal violence against women. Patriarchal violence involves catcalling, sexual harassment, rape and mansplaining. Women leaders are key to end this violence. Introduction of domestic violence laws, anti-harassment

laws, anti and anti-rape laws are results of pro-women in legislations. The presence of women in parliaments leads to conversation about gender-sensitive policies in policy making! This eliminates the likelihood and existence of violence against women.

Ending patriarchal violence will pave way to important humanitarian concerns like environmental degradation. Women leaders ensure sustainability of future generations by ensuring safe environments. That is why women take active interest in environmental protection. Women closely associates with nature and makes culture of preservation of environment for future generations (Ujal Das, Role of Women in environmental protection, 2022).

Similarly, most environmental activists are women. For example, Greta Thunberg, Rachel Carson, Jane Goodall among many others are playing key role for the protection of environment. Therefore, women are essential to ensure safe and sustainable environment.

In addition to conserving environment, women will also empower households to be equitable. With division of roles in

a household will be equal which will eliminate gender stereotypes. Women's serves as contributions and their ability to multitask is applauded.

Benazir Bhutto, Jacinda Arden are leading examples of managing households and public offices. Examples are their success has established that women in public sphere can manage both works at a time and so can men can do the same. This empowers households right from the beginning.

The world

Despite of exemplary women leaders, the world will not be a better place if women ruled it as women can be brutal and resort to war. There is a psyche stereotype that woman seeks peace more than war. However, it is not true as women can be as brutal as men and resort to war. Women counters stereotype and by acting tough and waging wars as a result! A book,

Why Leaders Fight, examined gender differences in military aggression from 1875 to 2004. It found that 36% female leaders initiated at least one militarized dispute, while only 30% male leaders did the same (2015).

So, if women who lead nations to have the same risk propensity as their male counterparts.

It is not only women who make humane decisions as humanity and empathy is not gendered. Everything will not change for better if women are in power. Since it is a feminist perspective that men and women are alike and equal, it is unlikely that a female ruled world would be much different. "I don't think anything would change as empathy does not depend on gender at all" (Marjane Satrapi, Persepolis). It can be inferred that people with same experiences and same level of sensitivity ends up being the same person. If women can make humane decisions, so can men regardless of their gender. United Nations was founded by men and it places human at the center of its entire charter and is working. So, humanity is not gendered.

It is not essential that women would help the cause of women as there have been many women leaders who barely did anything for gender equality. As women work similarly to

men, -they are unlikely to do anything more for women as compared to men.

Margaret Thatcher is the leading example of how she barely helped the feminist cause. They also resort to character-assassination of other female leaders.

Sheikh Hasina Wazed in her electoral campaigns character-assassinated female opposition leaders. Even some AI images of female opposition leaders in inappropriate attires were shared online. This indicates that female leaders can be equally disruptive for equality.

Women leaders might eliminate some patriarchal violence and gender discrimination, but they will unleash other forms of discrimination.

It is much likely that the world will be run by middle-class white-women who will discriminate against people-of-colour. Marxist feminists argue against such discrimination by other women.

Nickie Haley, Marine Le Pen are examples of such leaders. Nickie Haley despite of being of Indian origin, have ignored the concerns of women of color. thus discrimination will continue where gender discrimination will morph into other forms of racial and class discrimination.

Women leaders with power greed are unlikely to champion environmental concerns of the world. Power contest of power and geopolitics will override environmental concerns. Women leaders are equally neglecting environmental concerns as men. Currently there are 80 women head of states (World Population Review, 2024). However, none of these states show or leads any climate change concerns. They are involved in parochial domestic politics with no regards to climate change at all. As a result women are less represented in green transition. Globally, there were only 62 women for every 100 men considered green talent (Global Green Skills Report, 2022). So, despite popular belief, there is not much women are doing to tackle the climate crisis.

There is a growing concern that instead of empowering households, absent mothers lead to catastrophic consequences for the society. Since women are traditionally believed to be nurturers responsible for bringing up children, there is a growing concern that women will neglect their primary job of being caregivers. It also emphasizes that no one will be holding the fort at home. "It would change the

presumption that there's someone at home to sort out all the problems" (Athene Donald). Social-environ Neglect of children and household will have its consequences which will be destructive for children's development. This will result in increase in loneliness pandemic at home. Hence, absence of both parents, specifically mothers, will be destructive for society.

Despite destructive and imperfect consequences of female rule in the world, only women in leadership positions can bring much needed peace in the world.

Owing to their peaceful nature, women are less likely to resort to war. History has shown that women in peace process improves peace process i.e. For past 30 years, 13% negotiators were female.

In ~~their~~ Due to their participation, sustainability of peace process was improved. Their (Helga Schmid, Women's Leadership in Peace building and Conflict Prevention, 2021).

Moreover, there is less risk of the peace agreement falling apart. In the same study, Schmid argues that where women are absent, peace agreements carry a lot higher risk of falling apart and relapse into conflict becomes more likely. So, it is evident that

women are not only negotiators for peace, but sustain peace as well.

After sustaining peace, ~~and internationally~~, women lawmakers make holistic policies and decisions domestically. ~~It is not only~~ Men might make some humane decisions, it is the women that take a more holistic approach in making decisions, central that is centered around ~~were~~ humans. Bangladesh made significant progress in reducing stunted children under Sheikh Hasina Wajid. She introduced long-term strategies in nutrition-sensitive sectors such as education, maternal health, ending open defecation and improving hygiene while also diversifying agricultural needs. This holistic approach, one of its kind, successfully improved human development indicators and reduced population growth. Since women experience suffer most from such issues, they are more likely to adopt holistic policies thus targeting the most vulnerable section.

By making more holistic policies, women will overhaul the social system to make it more equitable. While there are women leaders who did not do much to ~~for~~ female cause, there are plenty more

women leaders -that are empowering societies while fighting for the female cause. Michelle Bachelet, first woman President of Chile, states -that transformation is only possible -through changing the way of decision-making and shaping policies, through inclusion and participation. In other words, through "feminist leadership". She later served as UN High Commissioner for Human rights, thus continuing her struggle for an equitable society. Similarly, Malala Yousafzai is the biggest advocate of women's education, and according to her only education can transform the society and for better. Therefore, it is women leaders who are changing the social system.

Racial and class discrimination is not unique to female leaders, but it exists along male leadership with an addition of gender discrimination. In fact, women suffer from double disadvantage. In male rule, for instance women of colour face twin disadvantage: firstly, for being a woman, secondly, for being non-white. Similarly a poor, brown woman faces triple disadvantage. Third Wave Feminists have raised their voice for layers of oppression that females face.

This oppression will end through female rule. There will be "no cat sexual assault, no catcalling, no mansplaining" (Sofia Hagen) Since women are more vulnerable to discrimination, they are more likely to eliminate it when in authority. Female representation systematically change gender stereotypes and hence eliminate various forms of discrimination (Lawson, Hiring women into senior leadership, 2022). Thus, women in leadership position eliminate discrimination.

Women not only end discrimination, but more likely to conserve environment for future generations. They are more likely to work on environmental protection as it impacts disproportionately impacts women. They are more likely to advocate for climate change treaties. Countries with a bigger share of women in parliament are more prone to ratify environmental treaties and adopt policies that address climate change (Gender Equality and State Environmentalism, 2005). They are more likely to strive for curbing emissions and invest in renewable energy. Women led-firms make more efforts to curb emissions and have better results for environment, society and governance. (Support for female entrepreneurs in Europe, 2022)

Therefore, women leaders make the world better by protecting the environment.

In addition to environmental policies, women leaders make better policies for work-life balance. They also ensure that both parents are involved in child-rearing. There is a misconception that women in public sphere will neglect households which is not true. In fact, women in parliament advocate for balancing work-life through various policy actions. Maternal leaves, Child care at workplaces and Paternal leaves are all results of women legislation. Their presence in their parliament led to legislation on such important laws that ensures work-life balance and effective child-rearing where both parents are present.

To sum up, women makes the world better by establishing peace, eliminating biases and holistic policies. It can be argued that women can be as bad as men or accomplice in bad policy-making. However, it is untrue. Women leaders have led by example in sustaining peace, making humane policies and ending discrimination. Hence they make the world ~~present~~ better through their leadership.
