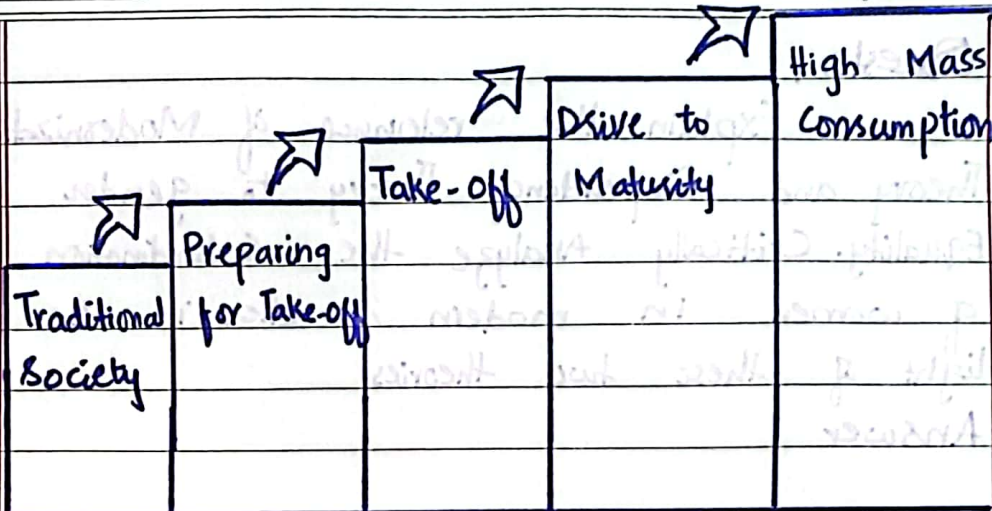


Fig: The Rostow Model
