The inspector told the people that they had caught the thief and he would be brought to the book soon.

8) The lady said to her husband, "Whether you agree with me or not I am not going to change my decision."

The lady told her husband that either he agreed with her or not she ^{whether} is not going to change her decision ^{was}.

9) The landlord said to the young man, "If you do not pay your rent by evening today you will have to leave the house immediately."

The landlord told the young man that ^{if} he ^{did} doesn't pay his rent by the evening that day he would have to leave the house.
