→ A house of bricks and mortar is built by them.
16. They are printing our book here in this press.
→ Our books are being printed here in this press by them.
17. People should take these medicines with care.
→ These medicines should be taken with care by people.
18. They distil the best wines in France.
→ The best wines are distilled in France by them.

19. The customer may pay money in instalments.

→ Money may be paid in instalments by the customer.

20. The police have interrogated everyone in the office.

→ Everyone in the office has been interrogated by the police.

21. They will keep all banks open this Sunday.

→ All banks will be kept open this Sunday by them.

22. We are warning you for the last time.

→ You are being warned for the last time by us.

23. They should open a college here.

→ A college should be opened here by them.

24. Your uncle could pay your fees.

→ Your fees could be paid by your uncle.

25. Someone has contacted him earlier also.

→ He has been contacted earlier also.

26. The government might hold elections next year.

→ Elections might be held next year by the government.

27. Some people stopped the train and robbed the passengers between the two stations.

→ The train was stopped by some people and robbed the passengers b/w the two stations.

28. They will discuss this question tomorrow.

→ This question will be discussed by them tomorrow.

29. They will expect you here on Monday.

→ You will be expected here on Monday by them.

30. Dirty water can spread cholera.

→ Cholera can be spread by dirty water.
