Global warming is a threat to social ~~life~~^{progress} as extreme weather causes lethargic attitude among people which effects their working efficiency and ultimately reduces productivity. The author of 'Why nations fail' counts extreme temperature as a reason of failure of nations and analysed that those regions which faces harsh temperature conditions throughout year are under-developed nations, those regions which experiences cold temperature are developed nations i.e northern countries. So, extreme weather conditions are hurdle to progressive world.

Global warming poses sever threats to human life. Every year world faced precious life loss because of high temperature. not only this, ~~year on year~~ increase in disasters is reported. According to World Meteorological Organization 2 million deaths and 11,778 disasters are reported in past 50 years because of extreme weather. Moreover 90% of 2 million deaths are reported in developing countries. Thus global warming has become a challenge for world and especially for developing and under developed countries.

Global warming has become a threat to fresh water reservoirs. As 97% of world water is oceanic, which means salty and only 3% is fresh water. 21% of 3% fresh water is underground water, whereas, 79% of 3% fresh water consists of glaciers. Because of high temperature glaciers are melting speedily. According to International commission on ice and snow African glaciers are facing with 82% of glacial retreat, Russian glaciers are facing with 50% glacial retreat, Tibetan plateaus are facing with 25% of glacial retreat. Pakistan's Himalayan glaciers are most rapidly melting glaciers right now. As per NASA, arctic sea ice loss is recorded 11.5° per decade. Thus, global warming has posed another challenge to world freshwater sources.

As heavy glacial retreat is observed in world due to global warming, this glacier melting resulted into rise in sea level which ultimately poses a threat to coastal life. Over past 120 years 8 inches rise in global sea level has been recorded which is increasing year on year. Indonesia changed its capital from Jakarta to Nusantara because Jakarta was sinking into sea due to rising sea level.

Almost 50% of global population is living in coastal areas within radius of 100 km. Thus global warming is posing serious ^{political} threats to coastal cities like Karachi, Chittagong, Bombay etc. Margret Mead, the cultural anthropologist has truly said "We wouldn't have society if we destroy the environment."
