## 1. Introduction



### 3. Principles of Islamic Social System

#### a) Equality for Mankind

All the mankind are same. All the humans are children of Adam and Eve and creator of Allah.

The Quran says:

The prophet SAW said, Do not waste water even if you are running on a stream.

Islam emphasizes to show kind treatment towards Non Muslims, Do not lavishly spend on worldly things. Help poor and needy.

### g) The structure of Zakat to eliminate poverty from the society

Zakat helps to eliminate poverty from the society and helps in removing inequality from the society.

circumstances.



The modern political system do not integrate the values of Islamic political system due to which it faces weak democracy, inefficient institutions and lack of public trust on head of the state.

## 2. Islamic political system is based on three pillars

The prophet SAW was send down by Allah and translated all the commands that were given by Allah.

Allah has sent down man as his representation and trusted man with the responsibility of Trust and Amanah which the countries had also denied to accept.

### 3. Main Principles of Islamic Political System.

a) To sign peace treaties with non Muslims

Islam is the religion of peace and harmony!

Prophet SAW always emphasize on negotiation and peace talks. When migrated to Madina he signed an agreement with Jews that Muslim and Jews can live in harmony and peace.

b) Do not charge Muslim and Non Muslims beyond their capabilities

The rate of Zakat is fixed whereas on Non muslim is also fixed so that they do not pay beyond their capabilities.

c) Every citizen should be safe

The tax collected by non-muslims was used as a social security to provide them from security and the Muslims were also safe.

d) To enjoy fundamental rights by each gender

The Islamic political system give rights to each individual, men or women to live as per they

desire while allowing them equal rights in all spheres of life.

e) To use force only when one needs to defend.

Prophet SAWs has always fought defensive fights and encourage people not to use force until and unless someone attacks them.

#### 4. Features of Islamic Political System

##### i) Government by Consultation

Prophet SAWs posses great knowledge and skills but he always consulted with his companion before making any decision.

At the time of Battle of Uhud, the prophet wanted to fight from inside but his companion agreed to follow from outside.

Prophet SAWs always encourage people to make consultation as,

Many Muslims cannot agree upon (iii)  
on wrong.

Even after the death of Prophet SAWs consultation was made and Majlis-e-Shura is an example of it.

### ii) Rule of law

Prophet SAW never considered himself above the rule of law. He always emphasize that rule of law is same for Muslims and Non-Muslims.

Prophet SAW said, even if my daughter commit theft, her hand will be separated.

This states Islamic political system doesn't favour anyone.

### iii) Obedience of the ruler

Whoever obeys Allah obeys me, whoever obeys me so will obey his leader that is chosen among you people and who ever disobeys him will disobey me.

Allah has send down men as his representation with the duty to guide and direct people.

### iv) Order good & forbid wrong

The political system of Islam encourage good and forbid wrong doing so that peace and harmony can be made in the society.

## v) Establishment Of Zakat System

The collection of Zakat is necessary so that the wealth cannot be accumulated in few hands. Zakat helps to purify the wealth and soul. It helps to eliminate poverty and inequality from the society.

## vi) Helps in maintaining Justice in the Society

Islamic Political system provides fair and equal Justice to all its citizens. Prophet SAWs stated that no one is above the law.

## vii) To promote Tolerance & Coexistence

To Promote tolerance and coexistence. That is to allow different people from different religion to live under one state allowing them rights of freedom, education, security and speech.

In Islam There is no compulsion on Deen.

## viii) The Rights of non Muslims, in addition to an Islamic state


The Islamic political system provides a fair and equal representation of each citizen into the society despite of its religion, gender, caste or wealth.
