Critically examine the policies of the Congress Ministries of 1937? How it paved the way for separate Muslim homeland in India. Explain.

INTRODUCTION:

Muslims ruled the sub-continent for centuries. After the War of Independence, 1857, the sun set to Muslim empire. The next ninety years, British ruled the sub-continent. However, in these ninety years, Hindus made significant development in every field of life and they got an opportunity to rule almost nine provinces ^{in sub-continent} after 1937 elections. During this short period of Hindu rule, Congress ministries relentlessly suppressed the Muslims through their policies, Hindi made a national language, vidya mandir scheme etc. These anti-muslim policies made muslim cautious about their future and paved the

way for separate homeland.

Congress Ministries

The Congress won 706 out of 1171 seats and made government in seven provinces. Initially, ~~the~~ the Congress did not set up ministries for about four months while demanding British government to ~~not~~ interfere in its legislative affairs. However, the Congress Ministries form under 1935 India act in July 1937.

Bitter Policies of Congress Ministries

The Congress policies posed a significant challenge to the future of Muslim of sub-continent and made them realize that if Hindu ruled the subcontinent after the British expell, Muslim

would lose the social and culture identity. These policies were in following flow chart

7. Urdu cannot be left opting Hindi as national language

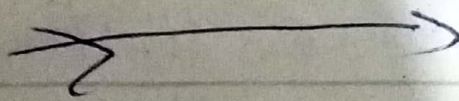
