3) How criminal neglect of child labor manifests in the world

a) High rate of poverty in developing and under developed countries.

Case in Point: About 1.1 billion people out of 6.1 billion live in acute poverty across developing

countries (UNDP Report)

b) Lack of educational opportunities ~~to~~ for children

Case in Point: About 3.3 million children are targeted for child labor in Pakistan due to lack of education (Institute of Business Administration)

c) Weak legal frameworks contribute to the prevalence of child labor

Case in Point: In Afghanistan, more than a third of boys and a quarter of girls between ages of 5 and 17 are engaged in hazardous child labor due to weak legal system (UNICEF Report)

d) Unregulated informal economy results in child labor.

Case in Point: Child labor in 22 Sub-Saharan African countries is due to informal economy (ILO Report)

e) Migration and displacement ~~are~~ as catalysts for child labor

Case in Point: Displacement during Vietnam War ~~lead~~ led to child labor due to dire economic conditions

4) Consequences of criminal neglect of child labor

a) Physical consequences of criminal neglect of child labor

- Exposure of children to variety of occupational hazards
 - Higher risks of injuries and accidents
 - Suffering from malnutrition due to inadequate access to proper nutrition

- A sense of anxiety about future
 - Contribution to low-self esteem and worthlessness
 - Deprivation from childhood leads to feelings of frustration
