However, this is not such a ~~problem~~, which cannot be addressed. ¹ ~~Government~~ ^{Government} can take various steps including; implementing strict laws countering informal economy, ² government must take steps to curb cross border informal trade, and ³ products in Pakistan must be registered before selling and purchasing. Additionally, informal economy has been declared illegal, unethical and unlawful by the World Bank. Informal economy is such an economy in which state is kept ~~an~~ ^{an} ~~aware~~, and its beneficiaries avoid ~~interacting~~ ^{interacting} with government's policies. The promoters and doers of this illegal ~~act~~ ^{act} do not pay taxes to government. In this way, state feels economic scarcity in country which is also happening in Pakistan.

As every challenge has solutions, likewise, informed economy can also become formal with if government in Pakistan implements strict laws to come out. Implementation of strict laws would lessen the illegal act swiftly upto an extent. Government should introduce impose penalties and ~~imprisonment~~ ^{confinements} to those involved in this curse.
