Q What is the difference between Deen and Religion? Describe the importance of Deen in human life with arguments. (2016)

Concept of Religion:-

In Arabic religion is defined as mazhab. Mazhab refer to road/path in literal meaning. Terminologically it refers to a set of beliefs, rituals and social customs. Mazhab deals with a person's individual and personal life and has relatively a narrower scope.

Concept of Deen:-

In literal meaning, deen refers to a number of things such as religion, beliefs, anything refer to god worship, government, day of Judgement, way of life etc. In contextual meaning, Deen refers to Islam; a complete code chosen for mankind by Al-mighty. It consists of beliefs, rituals, social customs and complete code of life.

Distinguish b/w the both:-

The only thing which distinguish between Religion and deen is **complete code of life**. Deen covers all the aspects of

person's life. It provide guidance in social, economic, political and administrative aspects. A man's whole dealings of day to day activities can be performed through the teachings given by deen. Contrarily, Religion refers to a person's religious life that how to perform and what not to do. It has a narrower scope.

Islam, Deen or Religion:-
