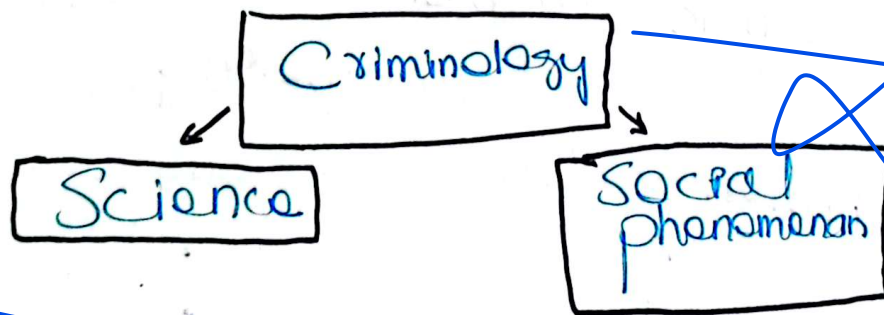


Explain the nature and importance of Criminology in detail.

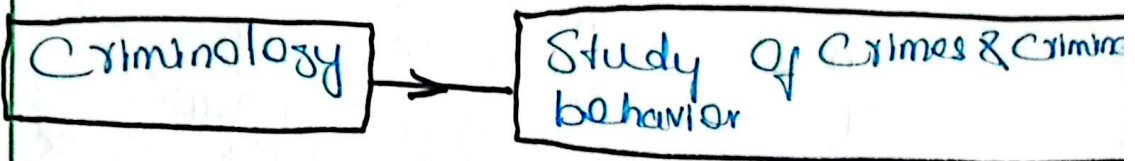

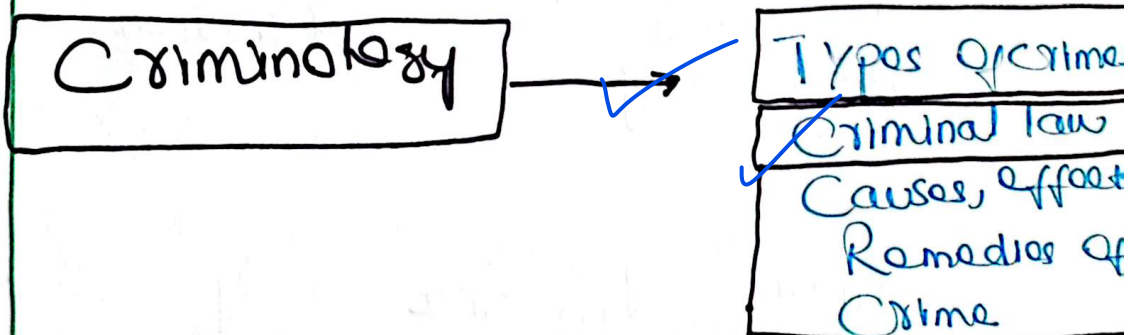
ii) Criminology vs Crime detection
