5th generation war:-

Fifth generation war is a type of war which is conducted by primarily non-kinetic military force through social-engineering, cyber-attacks, misinformation and propaganda with the help of artificial intelligence. Actually, this is a war of information and dis-information. This term was first used by Robert Steele in 2003.

Factors Responsible for 5th generation warfare in Pak:

The factors that are responsible or that pose the threat of 5th generation warfare in Pakistan are divided in two categories

i.e External & Internal Factors.

External Factors:-

The first external factor which is also the most important factor is

1. India as a threat:-

India is an old enemy of Pakistan (from birth) and is always desires to weaken our country.

5. Engaging International Stake holders:-

It is a necessity to involve international institutions or Stakeholders to help combating 5th generation warfare by passing policies. As this is not only the problem of Pakistan alone but the problem of whole world also. So, it is a dire need of an hour.

6. Good Governance:-

In addition to engage international stakeholders, the next important thing is good governance. The political parties or leader should not defame the state-institutions for their own interest. As it is destroying the image of Pakistan on international level.

7. Cyber-Security Revolution:-

Last but not the least is the revolution in cyber-security. The adversaries are attacking us through cyber-security. So we must counter them in their language. For this purpose, We must take a look at our educational system (which is ultimately the root cause of every threat) and try to improve them as quickly as possible.
