Importance of Din in Human Life

(Al-Quran)

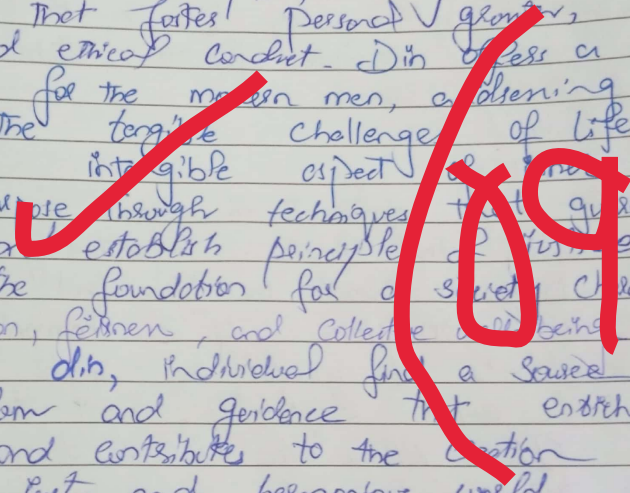
"Through these principles, din aim to create a just and inclusive environment where individuals are treated with dignity and where the rule of law prevails."
