

Q If Trump wins the upcoming election how would that influence US policies towards Ukraine, NATO, Middle East, China and climate politics.

A: Introduction:

The return of Trump by winning the upcoming presidential elections will result in a series of changes in the US foreign policies. Trump will end the alliance of America with NATO on the grounds of financial inefficiency of NATO. Furthermore, he will be strict in dealing with retaliations as in case of Iran. 6. Withdrawal of Paris Climate Accord
- 7- Political interference in women's right and personal health care.
- 8- Free and Open Indo-Pacific concept.

C: If Trumps Wins!

The first presidency of Trump was marked by negative and subjective political policies that bred hatred and chaos. If Trumps win the US presidential election of 2024, he is expected to follow the same political discourse as he did in his first tenure. The possible outcomes of victory of Trump

in the upcoming elections are elaborated as follows.

a) US Policies Towards Solving the Ukraine Crisis:

Donald Trump has criticized Joe Biden for not playing an active role in solving the Ukrainian crisis. He assured that he will "end Ukraine-Russia conflict in one day." 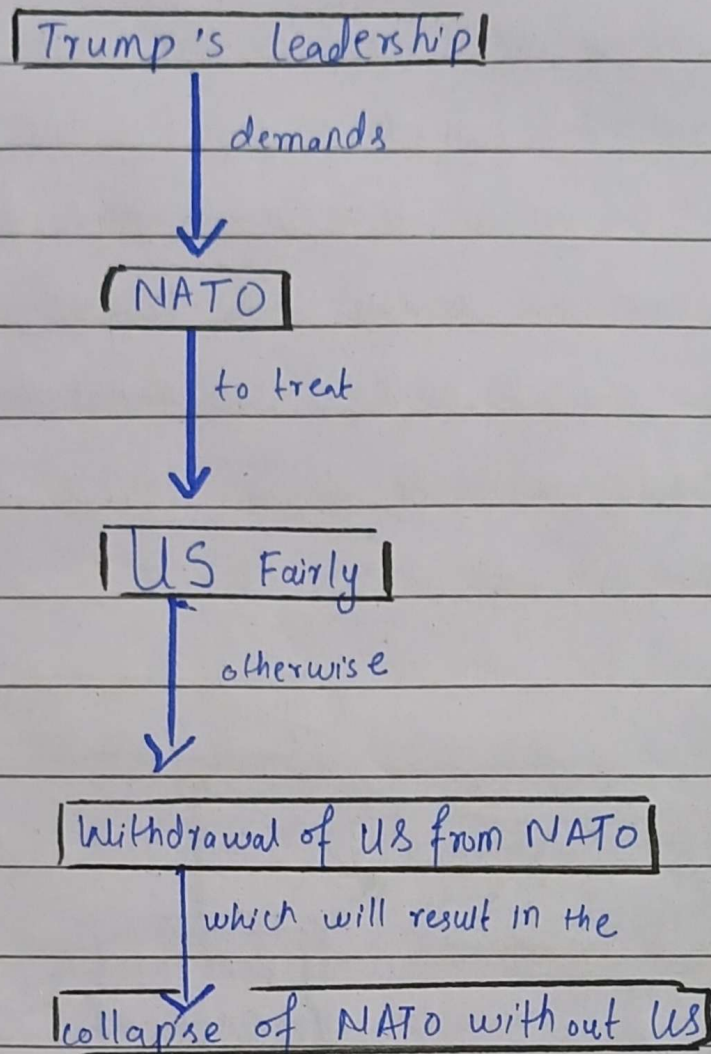
b) Trump and NATO: The electoral victory of Trump is likely to abandon NATO.

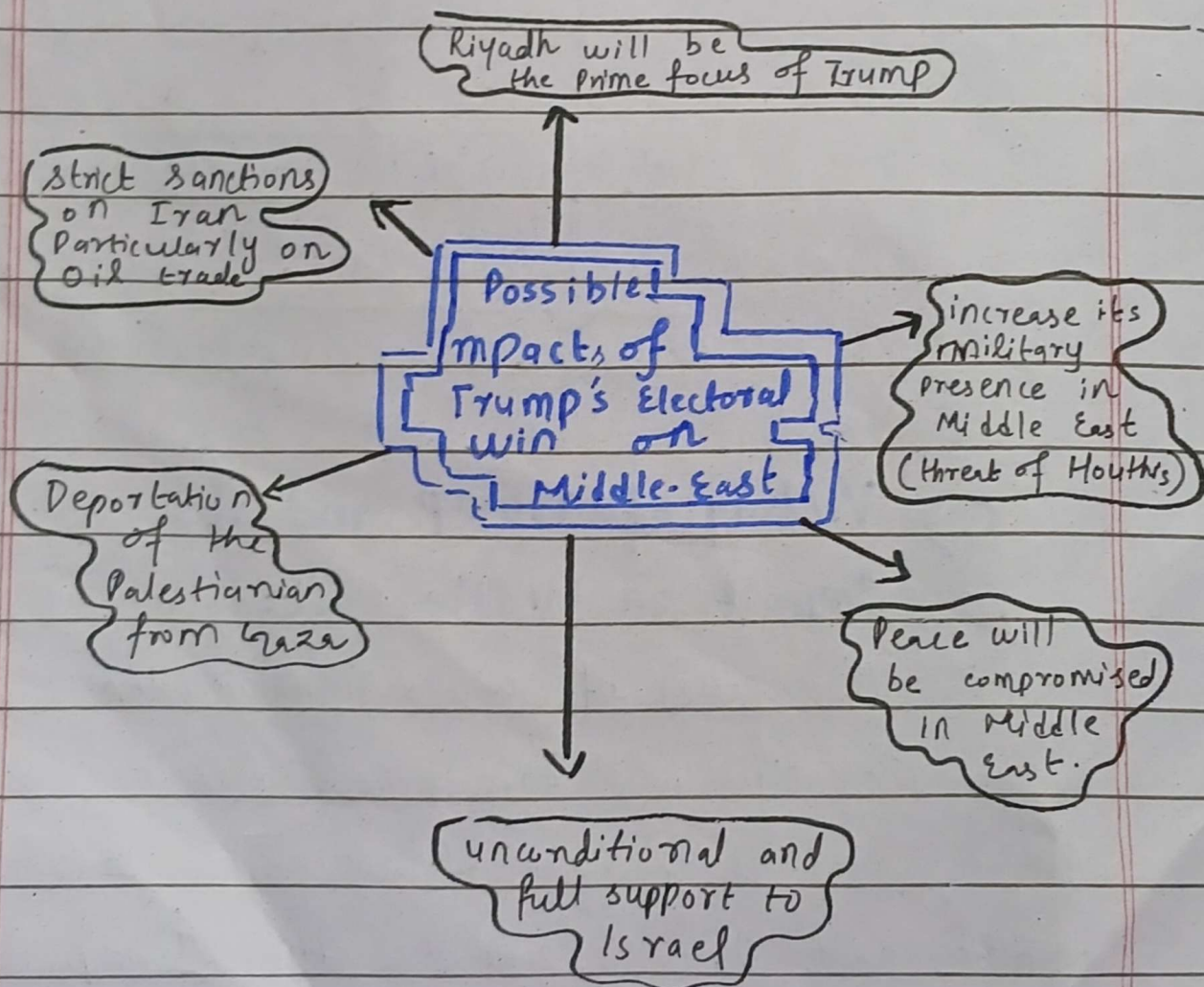
