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Pakistan's education system is facing significant challenges. First, staggering number of out-of-school children, estimated at 26.2m. This means that sizeable portion of the children is not accessing significant any formal education. Economic factors, cultural barriers and poor infrastructure are the primary reasons.

In many rural areas cultural norms may prioritise the ^{domestic} responsibilities over schooling, especially for girls. And in many ^{remote areas} places ~~that are~~ lack adequate school facilities. Additionally, there is another major problem is teacher's method of teaching is old. Traditional teaching method often focused on rote learning, despite of developing critical thinking or problem solving skills in the children. Moreover, classrooms are overcrowded, so the teacher faces difficulties while

severed, the quality of education for the 43m children in school in Pakistan is another major concern, as most experience poor learning outcomes due to factors like overcrowded classrooms, poor infrastructure, outdated teaching method, poor governance, insufficient resources etc.

Despite the significant educational challenges facing Pakistan, parents overwhelmingly express satisfaction with schooling in the country. Data from Pakistan social and living standard measurement surveys 2014-2015 to 2019-20 reveal over 94% parents reported satisfaction with schooling in the country.

Global boiling

On July 2023, Secretary General Guterres introduced the term "Global warming" to describe the escalating impact of climate change, indicating the planet transitioning from global warming to a more extreme and perilous state.

For instance this year, Haj turned tragic, 13,000 pilgrims succumbed to soaring temperature Saudi-Arabia faced extreme hot weather condition. Earlier in this month Pakistan and India has faced the same condition. In Sindh the temperature was 52.1°C and Mohenjindero has experienced 52.2°C temperature.

The Indian meteorologist department has issued red alert for the country's longest heat wave. Over 100 death and 1000 heatstroke cases have been reported. The temperature of Delhi has reached 42°C that affects the quality of life and ecosystem.

In UAE, Dubai has experienced

flood due to heavy rainfall. The flood wreaked havoc, resulting in death in UAE and Oman. Dubai experienced record-breaking rainfall, heaviest in over 75 years. ^{over} 1000 of flights were cancelled, due to extreme bad condition of weather.

Such rainfalls have led to flooding and fatalities in Pakistan and Afghanistan. Several deaths have been reported due to heavy rainfall.

These extreme weather events becoming more frequent, disturbing and affecting human health and ecosystem. The weather is so unpredictable. These heat waves melting glaciers that cause flood, thawing of permafrost releases green house gas methane, exacerbating global warming.

There is ^{urgent} need of quick actions to mitigate the escalating climate change conditions. Climate change does not ^{only} affect variety of life but also has impact on country's economics.
