Although US a democratic champion state never elect a single women President in their history. That shows that Political discriminations, Social injustice and Economic inequalities are exist everywhere in world. Sexual harassments and Repres cases is Reported in world wide. In some cases there are more discrimination in first world than the third world. So feminism is very much a Global issue.

To begin with, it is important to understand what the term feminism mean. Feminism is advocacy the women's right in the case of political, Economic and Social aspects. It enforce that women should Given the same opportunity that man have. According to women often, historian of Modern western European women's history, that "The name given to a comprehensive critical response to the deliberate and systematic subordination of women as a group by men as a group with given cultural setting.

Sweden, for instance, while having a good record of women's representation in most institutions, has never had a single female prime minister and only one-third of its mayors are female. Feminism in first world as like third world is a major issue in case of Authority. US which consider as a initiator of Democracy not elect a single women as president in US history. In 2016, Hillary Clinton and Trump was presidential candidate. Democrats use Melania's picture from her past fashion industry to denigrate Trump. In contrast, Pakistan elect Benazir Bhutto as chief executive. In Myanmar, Aung San Suu Kyi has been recognized by its citizen who elected her party in last election. So this fact show feminism very much global issue.

In addition to, women voters turnout ratio is very less. In many emerging democracies women are less likely to vote than men and when they do vote are likely to follow the wishes of male household and clan heads, as in some constituencies of Pakistan, it was even less than 10 percent of total polled vote. Not only this, the women turnout ratio significantly decreased during the US presidential elections in 2016, according to PEW Research institute.

Feminism is a global issue, women faced discrimination economically in every workplace. According to new Pew Research Center Analysis, In 2022, women an average of 82% of what men earned in United States of America. The U.S. Census Bureau has also analyzed the gender pay gap, through its analyze looks only at full time workers so in USA for every dollar earned by men women earned 82 cents. According to European Commission, that women earn 13.0% on average less per hour than ~~women~~ men. As well as, In developing countries like Pakistan has also a ^{difference of} ~~difference of~~ wage. A woman labour earn 500 ~~hundred~~ ^{rupees} a day and at the same time man for that same job earn 1000 rupees. So these facts and figures shows that feminism is a worldwide issue rather than first world issue.

Moreover, women ~~mentire~~ would have quota based or less number of seats in government sector as compare to men. In Developing countries like Pakistan only 10% of female present in formal sector while remaining are in informal sector. In case of India which is consider the world fifth largest economy has only ~~10~~ percent of female representation in major sector. This dilemma is same in the case of developed countries United States who ~~also~~ ^{is} ~~also~~ ^{is} its voice worldwide for women's rights itself has only twenty percent of congressional seats for women. Another most common example of Europe, which is consider as civilized nation also has only 30% of female

female representation in sectors. Then ~~is~~ How could we say that feminism is third world issue No, it's a global issue.

Furthermore, ~~women's sense nation and sector for the year of year - but they remain in same position.~~ Women should be economically strong for independence. but in case of South Africa only 20% of women has property in rural areas. As well as in case USA no women can hold a property in community. And According to the Atlantic, women own 1% of world property. In Rural India despite women sharing an equal burden as men in farming activities, if not more, women's ownership of land is abysmally low.

Women also face social injustice all around the world. This injustice could be of every time of torment, abusing or any process which harm the self respect of women. Every region or block has specific type of discrimination for women which make her mentally tired and emotionally damaged.

In addition to this, United States which is considered as world famous nation which is civilized and peaceful. The accused Dr Afia Sadique for almost of three decades and tortured her mentally and physically regardless of her gender. In spite of this there are many cases of rape &

Reported every year in world. - In Pakistan 11 cases of rape are reported every day - while in the case of developed country, According to statistics Norway has 42.02 per 100k, France ^{has} 35.59 per 100k, USA has 38.2 per 100k and Denmark has 37.26 per 100k case reported. So the violation on female is happen in every region and sphere of earth/world. So it shows that feminism is also third world issue.

Furthermore, Early marriage of women embark them with a bundle of responsibilities and early marriage child which can harm mother and child both because of this 17 thousand child born everyday in Pakistan out of which 4 thousand die sudden after their birth. This is all because due to malnutrition and early marriage. About 18% of girls in Pakistan married as children. Niger has the highest child marriage rate in the world among girls. In West Africa, More than 30% of girls faced under-aged marriage.

According to National Longitudinal Study of Adolescent Health, 25% of women marriage before the age of 23 in USA. So feminism is a critical issue which + be consider as global issue.

Despite of all, Gender equality is the basic human right. United Nations Organization should have introduced basic reforms for women empowerment - And Dislodge the term "feminism" politically, economically and socially. UNO created UN Women in July 2010

for Gender equality - and it's main purpose is to bring together resources and mandates for greater impact. Further UNO have to keep eye on some reforms which can enhance: 1. elimination of discrimination against women and girls. 2. empowerment of women 3. achievement of equality between women and men as partners and beneficiaries of development. Maybe these reforms prove fruitful for the rights of women.
