Describe the importance of Deen (doctrine of life) in human life. Differentiate b/w Deen & religion.

INTRODUCTION

The terms "Deen" and "Religion" are often used interchangeably, but they have distinct connotations and implications. While religion primarily focuses on spiritual and sacred aspects, encompassing belief systems and worship practices, Deen is a comprehensive code of life that incorporates social, economic & political dimensions. In essence, Deen is the ultimate destination, and Religion is a pathway leading to that destination. Deen is a holistic concept that encompasses both

Sacred and secular aspects of human life, and provide guidance in all human situations making it an indispensable part of human existence.

MAZHAB AND DEEN: LITERAL AND TERMINOLOGICAL DIFFERENCE

Maghab:

- > In literal sense, it means a path/
- > road. In terminology, it refers to a set of beliefs, rituals and social customs.
- > Concerns a person's individual & personal life
- > Has relatively narrower scope than Deen

Deen:

- > In literal sense, it refers to a number of meanings, such as religion, belief, anything through which God is worshipped. It also refers to government, judgement, Day of ~~De~~ judgement, way of life etc.
- > In terminology, it refers to Islam; the way of life chosen for mankind by Allah SWT.
- > It consists of a set of beliefs, rituals, social customs & a complete code of life.

ISLAM REFERRED TO AS "DEEN"
IN THE HOLY QURAN

Whenever Allah SWT has referred to Islam in the Quran, He has used the word "Deen" instead of Mazhab due to its wider scope.

اليوم اكملت لكم دينكم واتممت
عليكم نعمتي ورفيت لكم الاسلام ديناً

"This day, I have perfected your Deen for you, completed my favour upon you, and have chosen for you Islam as your Deen"
(Al-Maidah)

In Surah Al-Imran, Allah SWT says:

ان الدين عند الله الاسلام

"Surely the true Deen in the sight of Allah is Islam."

HADITH REFERENCE

Prophet PBUH also emphasized that Deen is not just about rituals or beliefs but also about treating others with kindness, compassion and sincerity. Prophet PBUH defined Deen as "Nasihah" which refers to advice, sincerity & goodwill.

الدين النسيح

"The Deen is advice"

(Sahih Muslim, Book Hadith 55)

The Hadith emphasized that Deen encourages individuals to be good, do good, and promote goodness in society.

SCHOLARLY PERSPECTIVE ON MAZHAB AND DEEN

Karen Armstrong, a British author and commentator on religious affairs, ~~defines Religion as~~ views religion as:

"Religion often tends to be limited to a particular set of beliefs and rituals and moral framework that guides all aspects of life."

Ibn-e-Khaldun, describes chief objective of Deen as:

"Deens are introduced by Allah in order to lead mankind to eternal blessings. Their objective is to worship Allah as well as management of worldly affairs. Deen provides guidelines to establish a composite state and government on the fundamentals enjoined by Allah."

COMPARITIVE ANALYSIS OF RELIGION AND DEEN

Religion

1. Subjectivity
Religion is an individual's subjective experience which examines every person's private relationship with A God.

Deen

Objectivity
Deen is an objective reality based on evident facts and holds its value as system of collective life.

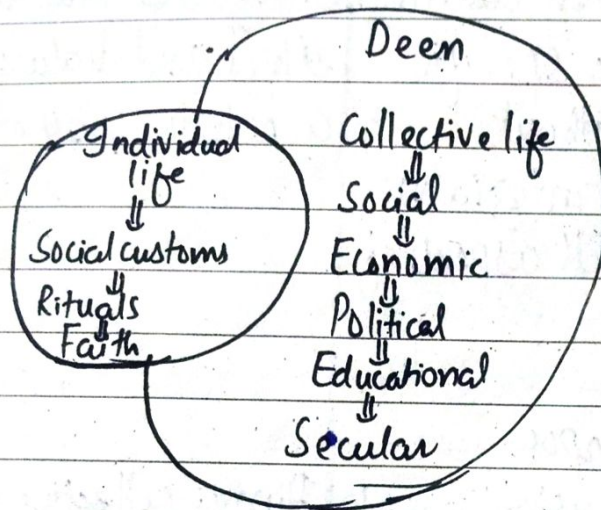

"He who created death & life to test you (as to) which of you is best in deed."
(Surah Mulk: A67:2)

(Surah Younus 10:62)

Deen promotes harmony & equality, rejecting discrimination based on color, race, class, or descent. Recognizing all humans as

God's creations, religion teaches that everyone deserves equal love, kindness, & respect. By following Deen, individuals can foster a world where everyone exists in harmony.

Hadrat Muhammad (PBUH) in His last sermon encapsulated the Islamic teachings for a balanced life based on tenets of Deen.

"All mankind is from Adam & Eve, an Arab has no superiority over a non-Arab nor a non-Arab has any superiority over an Arab; also a white has no superiority over a Black nor a Black has any superiority over a white except by piety & good action".
