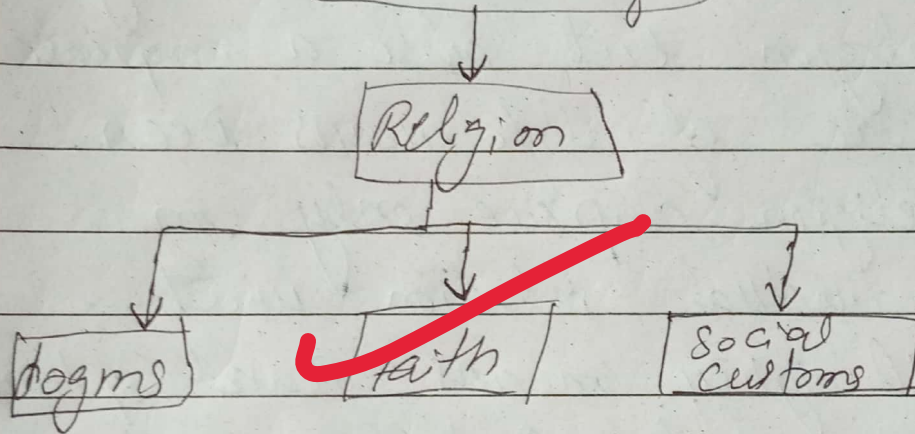


Q no 1 what is the difference between Deen and Religion? Describe the importance of Deen in human life with argument. (2016)

Introduction

Islam is not only religion but also a complete code of life means Deen. Religion comprise only on individual relation with Almighty means sacred sphere of life. But Deen consist on both sacred and secular aspects of life. It take into account collective life means economical, political and social relations. Deen is wider in concept and Religion is narrow. in economic, political and social affairs. Due to its wider concept or scope Allah has used word Deen in Quran instead of religion (mashab)

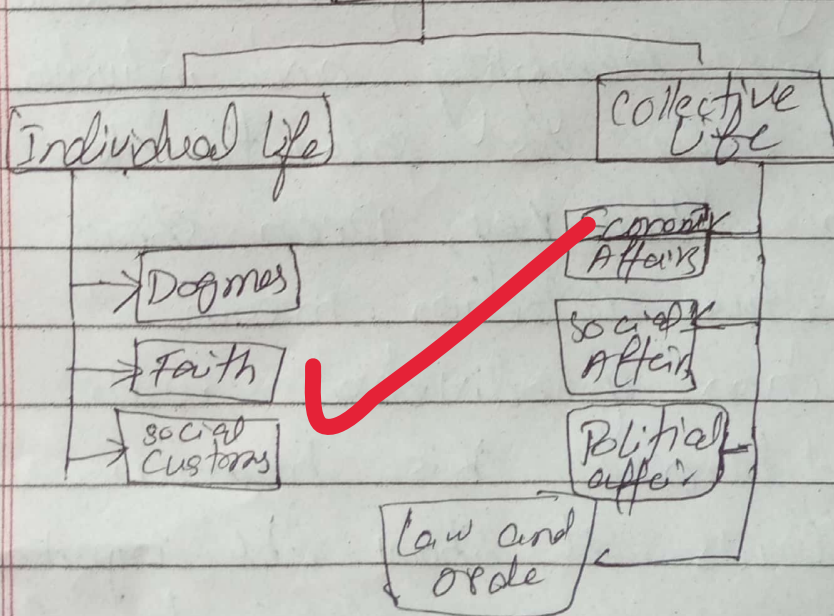
"This day, I have perfected your Deen for you, completed my favour on you, and chosen Islam for you as your Deen."

Difference between Religion and Deen

Difference between religion and Deen is based on following concepts

(1) Scope :

The scope of religion is narrow and it is subjective. But Deen is wider scoped and based on objective reality or collective life.

(2) Sort of Relationship :

Religion shows private relation between Almighty and individual and only his salvation to 'Him'. However, Deen shows collective relation. mean relation of individual with 'God' and his human fellows. It show the importance of welfare of and progress of other human fellows.

(3) Struggle of life :

Religion teaches his follower to flee from struggle of life and live without hardships in life. On the other hand, Deen teaches to compete against hardships with courage and rich reach at highest point of life above the mountains.

"There is something for those, who struggle for it"

(Al Quran)

(4) Concept of Fatalism:

Religion teaches individual concept of fatalism and divert them from self-improvement and development. While, Deen teaches them to struggle to change their

fates and get rewards both in this life and Hereafter.

(5) Concept of matter (wealth):

Religion ask them to renounce material of world and get paradise (Jannah) in Hereafter. But Deen (Islam) teaches his followers to work for worldly-material and save for Hereafter. Islam (Deen) ordered them to spend good life in this life and in Hereafter too.

(6) Self motives:

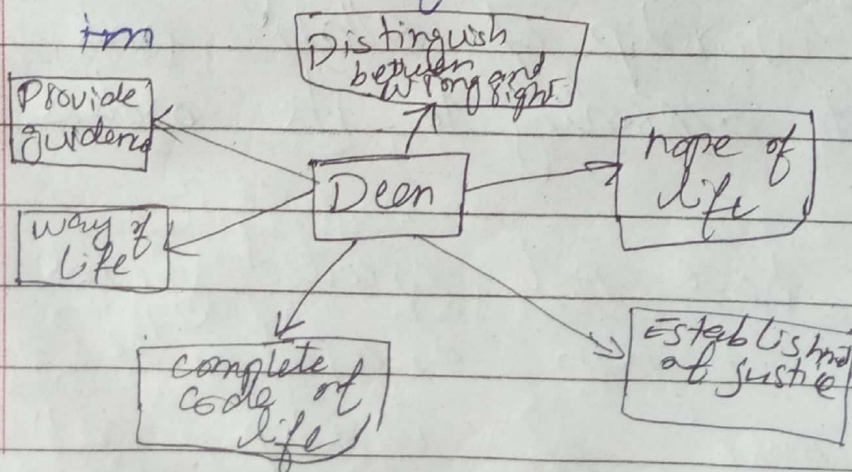
Religion is self motive because its is only relation between Almighty and individual who want reward in Hereafter. But Deen teaches to be open and help others, needy and poor. It ordered them
