Deen Vs Religion

Introduction

Deen and religion, both terms are used interchangeably, but they have slightly different connotations and implications. Religion is a Latin word which means to bind together, to follow and to subjugate. It merely includes faiths and rituals of worship. Whereas, Deen is an Arabic word - whān means to attain supremacy or dominion status. It not only includes faiths and rituals of worship but teaches us complete way of life.

According to famous scholar Dr. Ismael Ahmed said that Religion is the name of 3 constituents

- ① Faith
- ② Rituals
- ③ Social functions

- But Deen consist of 6 constituents:

- ① Faith
- ② Rituals
- ③ Social system and social function
- ④ Political system
- ⑤ Economic system
- ⑥ Justice
