Meaning and Concept of Islam:

Islam means Submission and Peace. Submission not only to

only belief and mode of thought but in ethics and morality, social, economic, cultural, manner nation and international affairs of society or machine life. - O Mankind! worship your Lord, who created you and those before you, so that you may ward off evil; who has made the earth a resting place for you, the sky a canopy and who causes water to flow from the heavens to pour down on earth, thereby producing fruits/food for you. So do not set up rivals to God when you know better.

2. Prophethood, (Al-Bayyah), The practical role model of Islam:

The second part of Kalimah signifies that God has left nothing by guiding mankind. He has revealed his teachings by means of Prophet and Muhammad (Peace be on him) as the final prophet of God. To believe in a prophet means to believe in the revelation he received, to accept the law that transmitted through him by God, and to follow the conduct of life that he practices for humanity.

"We have not sent any messenger but that he was to be obeyed" (Al-Misa) (64)

Characteristics of Islam

1. Revealed Ideology:

Islam is divinely revealed ideology which was revealed on the prophet Muhammad (Peace be upon him), who is the last messenger of Allah. Quran says:

"Allah conferred a benefit upon the believers when He raised ~~to~~ among them a believer messenger from among themselves reciting to them his communication and purifying them, and teaching them the Book and the wisdom, although before that they were surely in manifest error" (Al-Imran).

Other religions claims to be revealed but their revealed teachings has been changed.

2. Simplicity, rationality, Permanence:

Islam is a religion without mythology. It is a divine

religion in its original form. He believes in the rationality of human beings and encourages questioning. The teachings of Islam are simple and intelligible, and are free from superstition. The oneness of Allah, the belief in the prophethood of Muhammad (peace be upon him) and the belief in hereafter are the basic articles of faith. These articles are based on reason and logic. All teachings flow from these articles. There is no concept of priest hierarchy in Islam. Everyone may approach these teachings and translate and dictate into practice. Moreover, Islam awakens in man the faculty of reason and transform his life from darkness to light.

3. Unity matter and spirit:

The unique feature of Islam is that, it does not divide life into just two parts. It believes in the human personality and guides about its fulfillment. Islam does not believe in asceticism. It does not avoid humans to acquire material things.

but to guide man to acquire it and live in prosperity. The Qur'an advises:

"O Lord! Give us something fine in this world, something fine in hereafter."
(Al-Burrah).
