## Submission before God

That the worship which acclaims that all power belong to almighty and He is the only sustainer and giver of every thing. So pilgrimage is absolute submission before God.

## Strengthen of belief

## Protection of faith

# Moral impacts

## Negation of self-righteous rigidity

Hajj is pure form of denial of self-righteous. When a Muslim visits House of ALLAH, he repeatedly recites "Here I am, O ALLAH here I am" that means he capitulates all his self in the way of ALLAH. Indeed, all power belongs to ALLAH. Muslim <sup>from</sup> all over the world, just for the pleasure of ALLAH, come and ask forgiveness because He is the alone who grants and forgives. Pilgrimages during pilgrim days set aside their egos and try to accumulate as much blessing as they can.

## Suppression the lust of materialism

It is clearly ordained that Hajj is obligatory on those <sup>only</sup> who can afford this journey. In this regard, a well-to-do person spends money in the way to Makkah. This wealth which is used in performing Hajj denounces the desire of materialism. All the worldly <sup>things</sup> that any one possesses are the blessings of ALLAH, so it should be the priority of a Muslim. Hajj is the trial of both physical and financial capacity, if it is performed wholeheartedly, it eradicates the lust of materialism.
