CONCEPT OF ISLAM

The word "Islam" is derive from the Arabic word SLM (سلم), which means to one's self resign to the will of God. In other words Islam means "peace" which mentioned in Syed Ameeb Ali's book "The Spirit of Islam". This shows that one can achieve real peace of body and of mind only through submission and obedience to Allah.

The fundamental concept of Islam is that the whole universe is created by Allah Almighty, He created man for a fixed period of time to be lived on the earth. Allah has

Prescribed a divine code of life for man and granted freedom to follow this code. In other words It also cover the political, social, economic and legal aspects of life because Islam contains clear and definite rules and practices.

As in Surah Al-Kahf Allah Says:

فمن شاء فليؤمن
ومن شاء فليكفر -

"whosoever wants, he should believe; and whosoever wants he should disbelieve."

Those who follow the right path revealed by Allah are considered Muslims while those who decline to follow the right path are considered Kuffar (disbelievers).

1. TAWHEED (MONOTHEISM)

INTRODUCTION:

Tawheed have been derived from the Arabic word (w.h.d) which means 'Oneness and uniqueness.' He is present everywhere in the universe and Controller of the world and of mankind. Tawheed is core belief of Muslims. This belief is all about accepting and believing fact that there is no other God except Allah Almighty.

Similarly, at another place it has been stated in Quran that:

"O humankind! worship your Lord (Allah) who created you and those who were before you, so that you may become Al-muttaqun (the pious). (Al-Baqarah 2:21).

2. PROPHETHOOD (RISALAT)

INTRODUCTION:

Risalat has been derived from the Arabic word (RSL) which means "to send." In other words, to convey the message of Allah to his worshippers.

Although, Prophethood is the second part of Kalimah after Tawheed. God has transmitted the divine message to the people through His prophets, they are called Rasool. The divine message is given to them through revelation. The prophet do not say anything from their own but only transmit the Sharia.

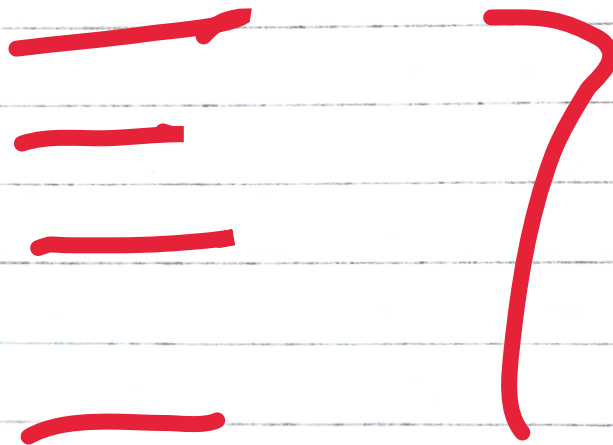
It has been stated about prophethood in Quran.

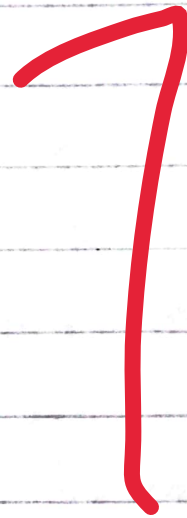
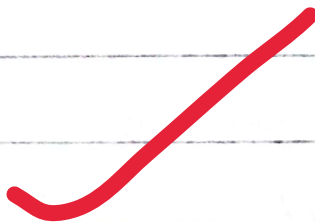
Holy prophet said about akhirat;
